### SOUTHERN RAILWAY DEPOSITS.

In a series of articles published within the last twelve months in this journal, we have pointed out to our readers the many unmistakable proofs of the country's great progress. For the public writer in the Plata, perhaps no theme can be more agreeable, since the subject needs no great pains or study, or classic lore to be handled, and it is not essential to be the oldest inhabitant to discuss improvements that grow with the trade and industry that create them.

ing that even in the greatest parts of Europe, or the United States, few railways can boast of larger or better mounted goods deposits.

It was our pleasant task, during the Carnival holidays, to make an editorial pilgrimage to these deposits, which are so recently finished, and at the hydraulic shire gather process and so on view about these new lights and powers which, since the days of Thales, have arrested the inquiry of man.

These new deposits were begun in June, 1883, and in use in October of the same year. They are 650 feet long and 55 feet wide, have 4 floors, and admit three lines of railways; corrugated iron walls, with glass and French tile roof, beneath which from 400 to 500 wagons can with ease be unladen.

On the upper floor is chiefly wool that is brought in from the country in the company of "lienzos" whilst on the lower floor is the wool brought in in bulk in the bullock carts; also hides, sheepskins, tallow and grain. The company has 50,000 "lienzos" and 10,000 bags in constant use, and the charge to the farmers and estanciaeros for them is but 20 cents of a paper dollar in the freight. As we descended the stairs and enter the gallery, you obtain one of the "lienzos" of the wool business of Buenos Aires. One vast exhibition of piles of wool, around each pile are buyers and sellers. Nothing that we had ever seen in the Plata rivalled the "coup d'oeil" on entering that gallery.

EDITOR'S TABLE

The French steamer Congo brings dates from London to the 6th and Lisbon 9th inst. Baker Pasha's defeat is as bad almost as Hick's. Eight thousand men were sent from England to Soukinn. The French had to fight for three days before they could take Suez Bay.

The National Bank began issuing new fifty cent notes yesterday. The following is the very latest about Chinese Gordon. The Sultan of Darfur seems to be rather a fast young man, but it is some comfort to learn that he is the wrong young man in the right place. The Standard-Gordon correspondent says—General Gordon has telegraphed up to Khartoum, "You are men, not women. Do not mind. I am coming." and down to Cairo to say that the young who were sent up with him as Sultan of Darfur has been incapable from drink ever since he left Cairo, and is totally unfit for the responsibilities of his position. It is now discovered that the wrong man has been sent."

The Daily Telegraph correspondents states that he is officially assured that the Greek fleet is the same which has with him only to Assassinate. Advances to £1,190,000 will be made by Greek merchants at Khartoum. The way in which the "admiral" do" is being done is simply wretched. By the time the end of the square is reached the other is in holes, just as if the traffic had been on it for half a dozen years. The stones are also very badly squared up. The present is a time of "high jinks" for the quarries—both mater and man—and it is not to the order of the day; anything will do. The laying of them is the same: the "official" catches hold of an adagio and then it goes, no matter if it is a inch thicker than the rest. A zig-zag line is of small moment. Some of it may survive the winter, but we predict a heavy bill for repairs next spring.

The telegrams from Montevideo say that Carnival has been wretchedly slow down there, although some enthusiastic persons started a special journal to try and put some life into it. What folly! The floods on the West Coast are far worse than at first supposed. At Arequipa there was a dreadful panic. Many villages have been swept away wholesale, and hundreds have been drowned. Thirty miles of the Peru and Arequipa Railway have been swept away. At Arequipa alone, the loss is estimated at a round million dollars. The Imperial Family and Court of Brazil have gone into mourning for two months, for the death of the Duchess of Saxon.

A correspondent of the Times writes: "The increase in the consumption of sugar in the United Kingdom during the last ten years is immense. In 1843 it was about 200 hundred thousand tons; in 1844 it was doubled, being equal to four hundred thousand tons; in 1874 it amounted to eight hundred and fifty thousand tons, and in 1883 to not less than one million tons."
