

ARGENTINE FINANCES.

A RETROSPECT OF SIX YEARS.

A summary report by the Finance Department, dated October, 1884, gives a simple statement of the national expenditure in the last six years. The revenue in that period amounted to 137 millions, and the cost of Government to 134 millions, leaving a surplus of 3 millions, or \$50,000 per annum.

The total expenditure, however, for the six years reached 182 millions, or \$45,000 per annum.

The average cost of governing the Republic was 22 million dollars per annum, against 16 millions in the preceding term of six years, and 123 millions in the period of 1866-72.

In other words, the ordinary cost of government rose 70 per cent. in 12 years, a natural consequence of the developed resources of the country. Allowing the same rate of increase, the cost of administration should now reach 29 millions, exclusive of any money that may be spent on new railways, iron-clads or other extraordinary items.

The extraordinary expenditure during the above six years was \$45,000,000, of which a little more than half went in public works—say \$25,292,000—the balance (nearly 23 millions) being swallowed up by additional war expenditure unprovided for in the Budget.

The new emissions of Government stock from 1875 to Dec. 1883 were:

The average cost of governing the Republic was 22 million dollars per annum, against 16 millions in the preceding term of six years, and 123 millions in the period of 1866-72.

In other words, the ordinary cost of government rose 70 per cent. in 12 years, a natural consequence of the developed resources of the country. The extraordinary expenditure during the above six years was \$45,000,000, of which a little more than half went in public works—say \$25,292,000—the balance (nearly 23 millions) being swallowed up by additional war expenditure unprovided for in the Budget.

The new emissions of Government stock from 1875 to Dec. 1883 were:

The above loans, although nominally exceeding 60 millions, did not realize much over 48 millions, which is just the amount of extraordinary expenditure for railways, docks, ironclads, etc., shown above. Here we see at a glance how the money was spent, that is, what became of the 60 millions added to the public debt since 1880.

It is well to know this, because there is such a strong prejudice against S. American republics that people in Europe readily believe that millions of public money are embezzled by persons in office.

But it must be confessed that the expenditure in the republic is lavish, and that the cost of government ought not to exceed 30 million dollars per annum. Canada has a much larger population and spends only 25 million dollars.

If we subtract railways and extra taxes we find the expenses of the republic for 1883 compare with 1878 as follows:

There is no need of a Herodotus in finance to put the accounts of the republic on a smooth and secure footing. The revenue exceeds 37 millions, the total expenditure, exclusive of service of foreign debt, is 25 millions, and the service of foreign debt is \$8,360,000 in gold (which may be safely put as not exceeding 11 millions in currency), say 16,36 millions, which would leave a surplus of one million.

Unfortunately there is a skeleton in the cupboard, viz., the Floating Debt, the amount of which no man knoweth. The Minister, in the report before me, estimates it at \$26,850,000, which is just 10 times more than it ought to be.

The first step towards reform should be to fund 25 millions, in ordinary Internal Bonds, and begin with a clean board. Nothing can be more convenient than to have so large a floating debt, with a Treasury in adverse conditions.

Disordered finances in every country have the same result: emission of uncovered paper-money. Look at Russia, Chile, and Brazil! The Argentine Republic has too much wealth, too many clever men, to allow of such a currency.
