

MR. MULHALL'S NEW WORK. (From the "Liverpool Post," Nov. 4th.)

Now that the prolonged depression in the prices of all kinds of commodigreatest national industries, and led to the appointment of a Commission on Trade, the moment is particularly opportune for the publication of a review of prices over a lengthened period. The appearance of a "History of Prices since the year 1850," by so competent an authority as Mr. Mulhall, which has just been issued by Messrs. Long-

The time under review, moreover, is in many respects remarkable.
