The Italian Minister in the Mount, the Duke of Lucignano, is seriously ill. Mr. Chiquito de Eibar and his partners got thrashed in the ball match on Sunday, in Plaza Euzkara. The place was literally packed with busy Basques, and there was the usual shouting, horse-lauding, and general confusion.

The cream of the French community was at the new French Hospital in Calle Rioja on Sunday, to view the works, which are going on under the direction of the eminent French engineer, Monsieur Carre. The building will be the most perfect of its kind in all America. The new system of cloths—"Vidangeuse Automatique," invented only a year ago by M. Mouras of Vincennes, and which is being adopted all over France, has been adopted and improved on by M. Carre. The basis of this new system is the discovery that all fecal matter becomes dissolved and perfectly harmless after 25 days immersion in a certain proportion of water. All who are building new houses, or have had detritus in old ones, should interview M. Carre about this much-needed improvement in Hygiene.

Some places, like some people, are very touchy and liable to fire up at a moment's notice. Such a place is the "Industrial," an oil factory next to Larrazo's station on the Flores Road, which ended in smoke for the third time on Sunday morning.
