



The week opens under a thunder-loud, and the market is a nest of alarming rumors; the papers increase ne general distrust, and people wonder what mysterious causes are at work to perplex the public mind and endanger he public peace. That something has gone wrong seems pretty clear, since all talk of it, but nobody knows exactly what has gone wrong. All are groping in the dark, and the wonder is that gold has not rushed off at a tangent. ne kerb-stone, the leading topic of disassion has been the prospective revotion that is to upset the existing order f things and impede the advent of the ew Government on the 12th prox. All this sounds very silly, but the public mind, from one cause or another, is in an unhealthy frame, and it is very omi nous to watch that the only people who laugh at these revolutionary fears are the very party who are credited with and closed very hard at 53.70, say 229.95% premium. Nothing was done The alarming rumors in the hall acted like a wet blanket on all stocks and shares. The intense gloom of the weather had also a depressing influence on the speculation. At eleven o'clock the gloom was so intense that Cimmerian darkness prevailed in the hall; outside on the kerbstone you could not distinguish people on either side of the street; dust clouds covered the heavens; and for years Buenns Ayres has not witneslection from the waters of the Plate, a beautiful contrast with the black canopy above. At half past eleven the city was plunged in darkness and people ran to

and fro to seek refuge in hotels and cafés as the first gusts of wind announced the approach of dust or rain. 


