TELEGRAMS

By direct cables via Lisbon.

Hamburg, 6th.—Twenty one cases and 8 deaths yesterday. The schools are being reopened with all kinds of precautions.

Cork, 6th.—There was a death from cholera here yesterday.

Haarlem, 6th.—In last 24 hours a new case of cholera.

Paris, 6th.—Cholera is considered at an end in this city.

Buda-Pesth, 6th.—Cholera continued to decline. Very few fresh cases yesterday.

London, 6th.—Lord Tennyson is dead. The remains will be interred in Westminster Abbey.

Rome, 6th.—A dynamite bomb exploded at the door of the Spanish Consulate, doing great damage, but there was no sacrifice of life.

It is supposed that the outrage was by some Monarchist. Some arrests have been made of suspected persons.

Vienne, 6th.—Rosenzweig has arrested second in the race of the Germans from Berlin.

The Austrians have won, but the difference in the arrival of the first on both sides is trifling.

Edinburgh, 6th.—German and Italian troops have been organized here, and they will be much feared by the authorities and Austrian military. They will be invited to a banquet and other entertainments.

New York, 6th.—The Democratic candidate has won the election for Governor of Georgia. This fresh victory of the Democrats, with that in Florida, causes great comment in political circles.

London, 6th.—The Avion race has been taken place.

Buda-Pesth, 6th.—There is a crisis in the Hungarian Cabinet. The difficulties about the loan and conversion to carry out the monetary reform recently sanctioned.

Weekend, the Finance Minister, is the Minister who is most determined to resign.

Madrid, 6th.—The Queen Regent has visited the Columbus Exhibition. The United States Section pleased her most.

The new German Ambassador, Dr. Radwicz, has been received by the Queen Regent. The speeches exchanged were very cordial, expressing a mutual desire to increase the trade between the two countries by concessions on the basis of reciprocity.

Huelva, 6th.—Canovas del Castillo has visited the Rabida Convent and the monument to Columbus erected in front of it. It is 65 metres high, and very imposing.

New York, 6th.—Telegrams from Caracas say that General Crespo, leader of the Venezuelan insurgents, has won a bloody victory at Tequipo, which has made him master of the situation.

The foreigner's Caracas are afraid that Crespo's soldiers will sack the town, although it is hoped that the North American warships will be able to keep them in check, if necessary.
