It is now proposed by Prince Bismarck, on the part of the Prussian Government, that Altona shall be annexed to the area liable to customs. Technically, Prussia is of course justified in taking such a step with regard to one of its own owns; but Prince Bismarck's propositions extend beyond this, and. actually would have the Hamburg suburb of St. Pauli dealt with in the same way. 
