At each of these there are killed annually 40,000 to 50,000 animals, making from that department 200,000 to 250,000 animals in the year. The beef is salted and dried in thin, large, slices and it finds a market in Brazil and the West Indies. The hides are salted and go to Europe, chiefly to Antwerp and Liverpool, and the tallow goes by cargoes, in pipes, to England. There are no manufactories in Paysandu but the small shops of shoemakers, tailors, waggon-makers, blacksmiths &c. &c. supply the neighborhood demand for ordered work.

Labor is dear both for house and farm service, the poorest laborer recoiving, at the lowest, \$16 silver per month. And so rapid is the increase of population by immigration that all kinds of marketing are as dear as at Buenos Ayres.

Casa Blanca is only a location for a saladero, but it has importance from the fact that Mr. Richard A. Williams and his partner at this place are engaged, in manufacturing a new kind of guano for which Mr. Williams has a patent. It consists of a mixture in ertain proportions of bone-ash and fresh blood. It has the advantage over the bone ash alone, first in weight, as the blood added gives the ash 50 per cent. more weight, secondly in value, as guano of this kind brings in England about 33 per cent. more than the bone-ash alone. Unless so used. the blood is always thrown away, and the work of the mixing is not great.

The chemical objections to the process have been answered by successful experiment. It is first allowed to heat or ferment in bulk, afterwards, tho it may heat on board, it does not ignite spontaneously. Three cargoes have safely crossed the Atlantic. One of the saladeros in Paysandu also disposes of its bone-ash in this manner.
