Here lies the body of William Weig— I have no more to say.

Very different is the sceptical, not to say rollicking, tone of the inscription over a certain Gabriel John—  
He lies the body of Gabriel John, Who died in the year eight hundred and one.

We might rather have imagined such an epitaph for Napoleon III than for the clerk of a quiet English parish. Here is the cruel remark on a doctor—  
Here lies the body of Dr. Chord Who filled the half of this churchyard;

We know that next door neighbours living in towns are apt to dislike each other; and we have heard a gifted lady venture on the splendid scientific generalisation that "people who live next door always play the piano badly." But it is rather too hard to cast covert sarcasms after the demise of both parties to "the woman under the next stone!"—Temple Bar.
