THE PEACE QUESTION. MINISTER ELIZALDE'S NOTE. Foreign office, Buenos Ayres, Sept. 26, 1866.

To H. E. President Mitre, Generalissimo of the Allied Army in Paraguay. I have had the honor to receive the notes of the 13th and 16th inst. giving account of the conference held with the President of Paraguay and the resolution adopted in accord with the representatives of the Allied Powers, referring the matter to their Governments.

Additional Mail Service to Brazil and the R. Plate. Her Majesty's Government having decided on the despatch of a second regular Mail in each month by British Packet to Brazil and the River Plate, the Postmaster General has been pleased to conclude a contract with this Company for the service.

Royal Mail Company's branch Steamer which leaves Buenos Ayres on the 20th of each month. All letters are required to pass through the Post-office. Neither Consignees' despatches nor other letters of any kind can be received by us for conveyance by the Mail Steamer of the 20th.

Letters, Newspapers, Books, and Patterns forwarded to Brazil and the River Plate via Liverpool will be chargeable by the Post-office with the same rates of postage as those sent via Southampton.

The service will be commenced by the Screw Steamer Hipparchus, 1848 tons, Captain John Carroll, to be dispatched from Liverpool direct for Rio de Janeiro, Monte Video, and Buenos Ayres on the morning of Thursday, 20th August; not receiving cargo after midnight of Monday, 17th August.

The last passage of the Hipparchus was made as follows:—Liverpool to Rio de Janeiro, 21 days 7 1/2 hours.

Stoppage at Rio de Janeiro, 1 day 17 hours. Rio de Janeiro to Monte Video 4 days 21 hours.

Liverpool to Monte Video, including stoppage, 27 days 2 1/2 hours. The Brazilian Postoffice Packet will continue to be despatched from Liverpool on the 2nd of each month (unless that day be Sunday, and then on the 3rd) but will no longer proceed to the River Plate.

An intermediate Steamer will continue to be despatched about the 10th of each month, of which due notice will be given as usual.

The Monthly Steamer direct to the River Plate (hitherto announced for the 18th) will in future be despatched (by the River Plate Association) on the 30th of each month (unless that day be Sunday, and then on the day following).

EXTORTION BY CABMEN. Gentlemen: As I am aware that the columns of your popular paper are ever open in the course of progress, I feel a little extra courage in thus trespassing on your valuable space, in order to hold up to light a glaring injustice.

It was a wet, raw, unpleasant day; however, we got on famously all the way from Chascomus till we arrived at Calle Lima, when stern fate stared us in the face, as without any ceremony whatever, we were landed, as usual, in the first open street, left to shift for ourselves as best we could, and fight our way through exorbitant coachmen, ambitious peones, dirty faced policemen, lottery ticket sellers, and the usual gaping crowd to be found waiting the arrival of a train. If you happen to have six boxes, six different peones pounce on them like vultures, but fortunately I was a little up to the sword exercise, and thus, with a ponderous gingham umbrella endeavored to ward off my assailants with the different cuts Nos. 1 to 9, assisted most gallantly by my fair friend, who vigorously wielded a hand-box over the head of the affrighted rascal. My first idea was to get away safely and as quickly as possible; hence, I politely asked a coachman his fare down town (seventeen squares), his reply was: one hundred dollars, (the price of ten sheep); another asked one hundred and twenty dollars. So, seeing the swindling going on on all sides, I determined to foot it, and appealed to my fair friend to do likewise and not be victimized, which she willingly assented to, although weighing seventeen stone; so we started, and after a considerable amount of puffing and blowing, we arrived at our destination with the feeling of people who had been taken off a sinking steamer. You can well imagine, gentlemen, what my sufferings were on the occasion. My rheumatism seemed to increase tenfold when landed in the open streets, besides the annoyance which the care of two live turkeys gave, whilst a chronic tooth-ache, (the property of my fair friend) commenced operations furiously; well might you have said "pity the sorrows of this poor old man," and I can really assert that any one placed in my position deserves every sympathy. I saw dozens of people the same night in just as bad a plight, but all had to get out of it as best they could.

Complaints against railways have become so hackneyed that no attention is paid to them, but let any of those who pooh-pooh such things, try their hand on Calle Lima some wet night, and they will have, as the Yankees say, a considerable change in their opinion. Mr. Banfield is an excellent manager and respected by everyone. He is the right man in the right place; but he must either run the tramway into town, or provide shelter for passengers who can't afford to pay 16s. 8d. for a coach, or pay a Doctor, if they get fever from wet feet.

The small office which the Company has at the Lima Station, is shut up immediately on the despatch of the 7.35. train to Barracas, or five minutes after the Chascomus train arrives. As naturally the employees are not imbued with any sentimental sympathy on such occasions, they must clear out to cafes, theatres, etc., and leave the passengers and coachmen to fight it out.

I am sure this matter has only to be brought under the notice of Mr. Banfield to be at once remedied, as I have sufficient confidence in his official capacity and general disposition to be kind and accommodating to his passengers.

The new board is composed of Messrs. George Temperley and Francis Moreno, re-elected, and Mr. Henry Hart.
