IMPORTANT FROM PARAGUAY THE GRAN CHACO DIFFICULTY.

The Goya has brought us later advices from ruined Paraguay, and

version of things, the Argentine Goernment claims all the territory on the right bank of the river Paraguay, which is known to us all as the Gran Chaco. During the time of Lopez the Paraguayan Government always claimed the Gran Chaco from the mouth of the river Paraguay up to Matto Grosso as Paragnayan territory, and at stated distances kept guardhouses along the river and on the Chaco banks to prevent the Indians from crossing the river. In front of Asuncion the Chaco is very low and at times marshy, yet nevertheless Paraguayans farmed large districts and had their ranchos thereon, eking out a livelihood by supplying Asuncion with grass and bay. Further up the river old Don Carlos Antonio Lopez in years gone by had started a French colony calling it Nuevo Bordeos, but through some hitch or other the colony failed, and the colonists for the most part left the country greatly disgusted, but although the colonists left the settlement remained. Villa Occidental was the name given to the place; Lopez established a colony of Paraguayans there, and put up a fort or


