OUR PROSPECTS. The conclusion of a war as costly as any ever entered upon may fairly be considered a fit opportunity for glancing at our prospects; and we have little fear of the imputation of optimism, when we elect to look at them as arrayed in bright and brilliant colors.

THE ADUANA CHICA. Although a week has now elapsed since the inundation of the public bonded warehouse known as the Aduana Chica, it is difficult as yet to ascertain the exact loss.

financial situation of the country as the most encouraging feature in our prospects. As far as imperfect data will permit us to judge, the revenue of the Republic in face of the late partial alteration of duties goes on expanding, and the conclusion of the war gives the Finance Minister a respectable surplus to deal with which it is but rational to suppose must sensibly increase under the conditions we have set forth.

Our credit abroad has been for some time a fertile theme with writers on finance. We have a vivid and hilarious recollection of a leading colleague's views not so long ago on the advantages to our home purse to be derived from the shutting of foreign pockets against us, and the gain in the way of amortization forced on us by a low price for our national securities; we have changed all that, as the steady and legitimate rise in their value amply attests, and to this movement the placing of our last loan on the most favorable terms we have yet obtained must lend greatly augmented force.

The present aspect of the Bolsa affords also a most satisfactory contrast with that which it presented some months ago and which we had frequent reason to animadvert upon. Then, we had the market for our public funds turned into a gambling hell, offering to the world for some months a spectacle of speculation run mad such as has rarely been witnessed, and giving a handful of reckless adventurers the opportunity of playing with the honorable members of the Stock Exchange. Now, we see an increasing appreciation of the true value of our improvable credit.

The subject of our prospects is one that might be treated of at great length with satisfaction and profit, but their variety and magnitude prevent the attempt in a single article. Colonization, agriculture, railways, and every useful enterprise progress at a rate which, if not extraordinary, is at least sure, certain, and satisfactory. We are at present and likely to remain so with every foreign nation; and if we have much to complain of in the way of internal administration in some branches, we have at least the knowledge that the power rests with the citizens of this country to grapple with the abuses now existing, and the will to do so should manifest itself in proportion with the conviction, that a country so favored by nature is destined to play a most important part in the world's history.

The real losers, we may state that the Aduana Chica is a large and roomy building covering about an acre of ground; it was constructed about the year 1864 for a public meat and vegetable market to supply the north end of the town, and was used for such purposes for about two years; but the proprietor, Sr. Madero, finding that the rents of the different stalls did not give such remunerative returns as were anticipated, and at that time there being great demand for private bonded warehouses all through town, the Custom House being utterly unable to accommodate all the foreign merchandise arriving, application was made by Sr. Madero to the National Government to grant such privileges as would enable him to convert his splendid market into a Custom House deposit or bonded warehouse.

WOODEN RAILROADS. The Commissioner-general of the Cordoba Exhibition, Mr. Henry Zimmernann, has recommended to Government the idea of Mr. Charles F. Robertson to construct by way of experiment a wooden railway from the Cordoba terminus to the Exhibition building, half a mile in length, and if successful a number of lines on this principle could be laid down all over the Republic at an expense comparatively trifling.

Mr. Robertson's letter to Mr. Zimmernann is as follows: "In compliance with your request I submit to you some particulars about wooden railroads in use in N. America and their suitability to the northern provinces of this Republic. I regret that I have not a copy of a long report on this matter which I furnished to H. E. President Sarmiento with more minute details and estimates than I can now give you."

15. Parties infringing any of the three above dispositions will be fined \$100 if the traffic of the cars has not been thereby interrupted, otherwise they will be considered as having infringed Art. 11.

16. Passengers by tramways are not allowed to use bad language, or behave indecorously. The conductors are charged to admonish and even expel any passenger that should be wanting in respect to the public.

town for half a year. This sort of a sentence is not very lawyer-like, but needs arise from the incomprehensible proceeding of getting a lot of highly respectable gentlemen, utterly ignorant of law, together, and authorizing them to act as prosecutors, judge and jury; under the circumstances...
