LOPEZ JORDAN'S ULTIMATUM. GEN. MITRE OCCUPIES GUALEGAYCHU. The Saturno arrived yesterday morning from the Uruguay with important news respecting Entre Rios.

Major Villar having sided with Lopez Jordan and notified Gen. Mitre that his landing would be considered a casus belli, the National Guards of the town elected for their new commander Colonel Luciano Gonzalez.

Nothing exact is known as to the movements of Aparicio, but the rumor that he was besieging Salto had no foundation. At Carmelo two vessels had arrived from Gualeguy Grande with 100 men to reinforce the Blancos.
