SOUTH AMERICAN MONTHLY.

As many of our readers may have been unaware of the existence of the English periodical, whose demise it is our melancholy duty to announce, we feel constrained, in giving the editor's valedictory to the public, to offer a few remarks; neither are we willing that the merits and utility of our deceased colleague should be judged by the paper at foot, which Mr. Thomas Armstrong has requested us to publish.

The South American Monthly was started in Rosario by the Rev. Mr. Carter, the American clergyman of that place, towards the close of the eventful year A.D. 1863. The proprietor and editor had, during years of pastoral service, observed (what perhaps the public did not) the great want of an English organ in that rising place; and what with the aid of religion and friendship a sufficient subscription was got together to cover the expense of publication; indeed, we believe that in the morning of its existence such was the sympathy and support which the budding organ received, that it was contemplated at first to publish The South American Monthly once a fortnight. But the heavy expenses attending this extra publication and the increased tax which it would impose upon the time and brains of the reverend editor defeated the project. The magazine came out monthly and with a punctuality which spoke well for the editor and proprietor.

It is to be regretted that we have not preserved a file of the South American Monthly since its first issue, for, if we recollect aright, the interest of the general reader in each succeeding number was preserved by means of a chain of amusing correspondence from some party in Santa Fé to his maternal relative in the States. The Monthly was small but decently printed, well bound, and breathed that tone of evangelical sentiment so usual in what is called Tract literature. There was nothing which even the most punctilious could torture into scandal; sanctity not news, pervaded every column and for cheap innocent juvenile reading, which appeared to us to be the chief aim of the editor, we, at least, believe it achieved its end.

We make these observations to remove the rather unpleasant suspicions which must necessarily arise in the mind on reading the editor's own statement respecting the arrest of Mr. Knaggs and his subsequent liberation on some technical flaw in the indictment. Who this Mr. Knaggs is we are really at a loss to say, but we suppose, since the editor attaches such importance to his history, that he must have been a partner in the concern.

The death of a colleague, however humble, is an event of importance to the society of which it claimed to be the organ, and we can imagine the sorrow of the English speaking community of Rosario at the unlooked for demise of the South American Monthly, a sorrow which it would seem from the paper at foot must be shared by two of the most influential and wealthy Britishers in Buenos Ayres, Messrs. Armstrong and Lumb. Yet, after all, perhaps it is unjust to connect these gentlemen with the "Monthly" since their names are mentioned more in relation to the church of which Mr. Carter was so exemplary a pastor, than the paper he so successfully edited.

Clergymen, as a rule, make poor editors. There seems to be ever a wide gap between the pulpit and the printing-office, and we confess we are not surprised that in the struggle which must necessarily have ensued between the pastor and the printers' devil, the latter should have gained the day. With subscribers who have even paid up heavily in advance, with two of the largest capitalists in the River Plate at its back, with "as many advertisements as the editor desired," and a plethora of patronage both at home and abroad, the South American Monthly sinks into an early, but not untimely, grave. The lesson is not without its moral. The wealth of a Rothschild, the patronage of a church, a missionary society, and a whole religious community, will not give vitality to a paper that is worthless as a news journal, and a sorry symbol of the civilization of even a hamlet.

The address which we publish at foot when properly viewed is one of the finest compositions extant; it removes every feeling of regret at the demise of the Monthly.

He and Mr. Lumb presented a valuable lot of land to the church conjointly, and Mr. Armstrong afterwards added another piece of ten varas to the lot, which he gave on his own private account, and subscribed besides liberally towards building the church. To other supporters of the church in Rosario, members, attendants, friends, and to the whole English and American population, we give our sincere thanks for the many proofs of friendship and regard we have received during a residence of five years in Rosario. Rev. Mr. Wood, who has recently arrived, is our successor.

To those of our readers who are interested in the fortunes of Mr. Knaggs we have only room to say that he was liberated though the informality of the indictment against him, and is acting as clerk in Buenos Ayres for the gentleman who took such an interest in his favor. If, on entering a wholesale store in—street you see a tall young man, florid, blueeyed you may guess who he is."

DR. CARRERAS.

A distinguished member of the Bar has favored us with the following biographical sketch of the late President of the Supreme Court:—

During the Dictatorship of Rosas he continued in private life surrounded by all the consideration and respect which his straightforward and honorable conduct inspired, and which the persecutions of the time could not shake.

When Rosas fell, the new order of things found in him a decided supporter anxious for the political reconstruction of the State. He was the first Fiscal under the new regime.

His important services, solid intelligence and vast erudition, became necessary to the Government, and he was called to the Ministry of Finance of Buenos Ayres, where his intelligence and talent for organization were invaluable in establishing the judicial power. He afterwards became a member of the Chambers, and finally President of the Supreme Court of Justice. The Federal Court again called into requisition that spirit of organization he had shown in other departments of State.

The Supreme Federal Court installed for the first time in the country, and the spirit of justice that actuated its decisions, prove the creative genius, intelligence and undomitable energy of Dr. Carreras, who imprinted on this body that systematic equality of action which is its credit, and which the country never before possessed.

Dr. Carreras has died at 60 years of age, worn out in the service of his country, which never can replace a man who has a magistrate has left the stamp of his probity, and as a jurist-consult of his learning on every public post he occupied.

He died poor, and even worse off than when he entered public life, for his life and everything he had were devoted to the service of his country. If Buenos Ayres is proud of her children and wishes to erect a statue to virtue, probity and talent embodied in a magistrate, it should be raised to Dr. D. Francisco de las Carreras.

EDITOR'S TABLE.

There was no steamer from M. Video yesterday, we are consequently without any details of the movements of the belligerents, except such as the telegraphic advices supply. Aparicio had turned up in front of Cerro Largo with 400 men, and by latest accounts was about to assault the town. The commander of the troops there at once sent 'chiques' to Gen. Castro's camp and to the capital. General Castro at once broke up his encampment and marched to the relief of the town. Bustamante left Montevideo on Thursday with the 1st-battalion of National Guards for Florida. The city is in a great state of excitement in expectation of important, perhaps decisive, news.

The Death of Dr. Carreras, Judge of the Supreme Court, which occurred on Thursday afternoon, caused a profound feeling of regret in native and foreign circles. The learned Judge had been suffering for a long time. He bore the very highest character for erudition, impartial justice and patriotism during his long career.

An interesting piece of fashionable gossip has just reached us from Florence in reference to the Gomez-Gavotti 'reclandre.' We hear on the ve-

ry best authority that the husband of "the lady in the case" is, beyond year or any, alive and well, and holds a place as employé in the Parliament House in Florence. His eldest child by Madame Gavotti, a remarkably handsome boy ten years of age, lives with him. Don Fabian Gomez and his fair companion are at present in Paris, where the young gentleman's wealth and the romantic story of which he is the hero, have attracted some attention.

We are happy to hear that everything connected with the British Hospital Bazaar is progressing 'a merveille.' Contributions are pouring in from all quarters to the fair patronesses, and it is believed the pecuniary result must surpass the most sanguine expectations formed. Such a halo of romance has been thrown round the whole affair by enthusiastic partisans 'gardeners of girls' etc etc, that a reference to anything in the way of 'refreshment' may perhaps seem out of place. But, at the risk of being accused of materialism, even on such an occasion, we confess to a very decided interest in the 'billet' department of the Fair. We understand it will be under the fairest and ablest direction, and a number of new drinks have been 'imagined,' some of them compounded with the charitable intention of modifying the intoxicating effects of the brilliant scene the Fair is expected to present.

It was yesterday suggested to us that we should send some of the most valuable articles in our Museum to the Cordova Exhibition, and an influential member of the Commission, delighted at the idea, kindly promised to reserve a specially good place for the Standard contributions. We promised to think about it in the interest of our adopted country.

A decree of the National Government was published yesterday appointing General Galarza, Commander-in-Chief of the Entre Riano cavalry. Another decree was also published yesterday closing all the Argentine ports on the Uruguay river, that may not be under the immediate jurisdiction and control of the Commander-in-Chief of the armies in the field.

On Thursday night whether from the sudden change in the weather which became bitterly cold, or from fear of the recruiting parties, not a soul was to be seen in the streets. The shops were deserted and the young men who generally pass their evenings so pleasantly chatting and selling 'trifles light as air' to lovely yet troublesome customers, stood shivering behind their counters till the clock struck 'the hour for retiring.' All wayfarers with anything of the native in their appearance hurried along in a furtive manner as if they already felt the dreaded knapsack on their shoulders. As far as the foreigners are concerned there need be no further fear of annoyance, as our excellent Governor Dr. Emilio Castro, has given the most stringent orders to insure that no further molestation is offered them. Even for Argentines obliged to serve the affair will prove only a 'promenade militaire,' as we are inclined to back our colleague. La Capital in the opinion that Lopez Jordan will be 'done up' in two months from this present date.

Our colleague, La Tribuna, gives us a piece of gossip of an unusual kind, which we believe is founded on fact. A young couple took an early train to one of the towns on the Western Railway this day week. On arriving at their destination they made for the church. The girl and her companion soon stood before the altar and had duly uttered the responses in the first part of the marriage ceremony, when Nemesis appeared at the portal in the person of an elderly lady of distinguished mien who, in reply to the clergyman's question as to whether there was any impediment to the marriage, stated that she was 'the mother of the bridegroom's first betrothed and forbade the bans. There was fearful consternation amongst the company; the bridemaids fainted, the witnesses stared, the bride looked unutterable things, and the clergyman shut his book and went to breakfast. As to the actors in this affair our colleague informs us that the gentleman's name is Carlos; that the lady is, or has been, on the stage, and has often seen "the pit rise at her;" and that the abandoned 'first love' of the would-be bridegroom is a very beautiful and accomplished girl.

The Provincial Chambers will be duly opened to-morrow. Governor Castro will read his message, which we understand, touches on many important returns. The Palermo Minstrels appear on Monday at the French Theatre, on the occasion of Mineral Water Phillips' benefit. The programme is so varied and attractive that it affords a veritable 'embarras de richesses' to the lovers of music, comic or sentimental. Mr. Moldoon, who has performed in all the largest cities in the world, including the Tigre, Colonia, and the country towns of Greece, will astonish the audience with a stump speech; and the Plantation Walk Round will be performed by twelve negroes from the coast of Mozambique, specially engaged for this occasion only.

The regiments of the National Guard that have been called out to meet the requirements of the Jordan war are the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th of Infantry, and the 1st and 2nd of Cavalry. The enrolment begins on the first and ends on the last day of May.

Some people express surprise at the appointment of General Hornos to a command in the Uruguay. This officer left the day before yesterday, and took a small body of men from this city.

To-day the pieces of plato which the English holders of the Buenos Ayres loan have for a long time contemplated presenting to Don Norberto de la Riestra and the late Dr. Alsina will be presented to the former in person, and to the Vice-President of the Republic, in place of his illustrious father. The testimonials consist of half life size statues of Canning, one of our ablest statesmen, and who was the first to recognize the independence of this republic.

Our French colleague says that there was a terrific war of words between some members and employés at a late meeting of the Town Council, when the language adopted was slightly unparliamentary and charges and recriminations of a serious character were freely bandied about. This kind of thing may be considered the death rattle in the throat of this antiquated and inefficient body.

Bad example is contagious. Two boys of tender years had a dispute some days ago about some infantile trifle. One of them, named Pablo Ross, seized a knife and inflicted as severe a wound as his strength would admit of on his companion. The young delinquent was brought to the police office, where bread and water for a month may prove a salutary lesson to him.

We were favored by the managers of Colon with an invitation to attend the general rehearsal of Macbeth on Monday night, and had an opportunity of not only admiring the admirable manner in which Señor Agostini, has trained the choruses and orchestra to a faultless execution of this difficult and beautiful 'partitura,' but of forestalling the great success that awaits to-night the new prima donna Mme. Ronzi, whose voice both for power, sweetness, and freshness, will, if we are not much mistaken, be found to excel anything we have yet heard on our lyric boards. Mme. Ronzi has barely recovered from the fatigues of a long voyage, and the inconveniences she had to suffer in undergoing quarantine at Esenada; and a rehearsal does not give full opportunity of appreciating to the full the merits of an artist, yet we heard enough of her to anticipate confidently that her reception to-night will be as brilliant as ever was accorded by our public to any artist, and she will at once become a petted favourite.

To a magnificent voice she adds that soul stirring and passionate execution which none but the children of a southern clime have the power of expressing. The opera of Macbeth has always found great favour with our musical public, although it has not been performed for more than twelve years. It was first given at the Franco Argentine Theatre, and was performed for fourteen months almost to the exclusion of any other opera. The last time it was performed was at the Victoria Theatre with Mme. Lagrange and Lelini.

A match is talked of between Adios and Cimarron, over eight flights of burdles once and a half round the Belgrano Race course, for \$20,000 mje a side, to be run on the 23d of Mje. Both horses have numerous backers and the event causes much excitement in our sporting circles. We continue to receive numerous complaints of the badness of the gas. Among others, an influential subscriber tells us that, although he has every day a person from the Gas Works arranging the pipes, the light is so bad that he cannot see to eat his dinner. In their own interest we seriously call the attention of the Directors of the Company to this matter.

The report of Professor Rossetti of the survey made by him by order of the Provincial Government for a railroad across the Andes at the Plandion Pass will be attached to the Report of the Provincial Minister of Finance, which accompanies the Governor's Message to the Legislature to be inaugurated to-morrow. Prof. Rossetti's report is most favorable to the construction of the railway. On the Argentine slope of the Andes the gradient is only from six to twenty-one per mil, and, although on the Chilean side it is more rapid, the difficulty can be easily surmounted. The distance on the Argentine side from Rio Grande is 175 kilometres, and on the Chilean about 120. Prof. Rossetti estimates the cost of the former at eight millions of patacons, and of the latter at six millions.

The younger side of the house of Cranwell has been just declared a member of the Pharmaceutical Corporation. New College on the Heights of Almagro. Within the last two days the Italian Consul in this city has received no less a sum than 15,000 patacons for 'papeletas' issued to his countrymen.

"The cry is still there come." Two more valuable additions to our already large collection of curiosities—No. 1. A sprig of the famous 'Norway oats' presented by a North American subscriber, being a fac-simile of the 'lucky stalk' with which the first grower in Pennsylvania made in seven years the enormous sum of 137,000 hard dollars. No. 2. Samples of 'Vicuña' wool from Salta. These animals were imported from Bolivia some three years since by Messrs. Whitaker and Palacio, and are found to do well in the Northern Provinces. They are extremely wild, and notwithstanding every effort to tame them, it is found necessary to kill the animals to get their wool. Formerly the skins were used, but Mr. Whitaker who leaves in the Humboldt to bring weaving machinery, takes home some to have them tanned and try their suitability for ladies' boots, &c. Messrs. Whitaker and Palacio have contracted for 10,000 skins per year; about 200 may be got in the Argentine Provinces, the rest must come from Bolivia. Three skins will give 2lbs, or just enough to make a good sized poncho.

An extraordinary scene that lately occurred in Valparaiso is thus described by a paper published in that city:—A woman fell down dead on Monday night, while engaged in dancing the zamacueca, of which she was passionately fond. Before nailing down the coffin on the following day, the zamacueca was played and sung in the mortuary chamber, for the friends and acquaintances of the deceased said, that if she did not get on her feet at the sound of the well-known strain then indeed she might be considered as dead as a nail. Half an hour's scripping on the strings of a guitar, the screeching of several female singers, and the shuffling of the feet of sundry couples, having filled, however to induce the defunct to upon her eyes, and much less to assume a perpendicular position, she was unanimously declared to be dead as a stone, and a parting glass having been taken to her memory, the lid of the coffin was nailed down and the assembly of would be resuscitators of the departed then dispersed, each one regretting the unsuccessful result of their experiment.

A very remarkable woman lately died in Valparaiso named Candelaria Perez. Her career was an extraordinary one. At the time when Chile sent an expedition, under General Bulnes, to Peru to operate against the armies of the Peru-Bolivian confederation, Candelaria, who resided in Callao, joined the Chilean army, and proved of great service as a guide. She was present at all the principal battles that occurred during the campaign, and was several times wounded; she is also said to have to have given numerous proofs of extraordinary courage. She obtained the rank of sergeant during the campaign, and a few years since that of sub-lieutenant. The funeral was numerously attended, and a piquet of the 1st Battalion of the Line performed the honours due to the rank of the deceased.

EMIGRATION TO BUENOS AYRES. To the Editor of The Bulletin. Sir,—Advertisements from Her Majesty's Emigration Commissioners, together with placards of a similar description, have lately been put forth warning emigrants to the Argentine Republic of the insecurity of life in that country, owing to insufficient administration of the criminal laws.

As an Englishman qualified to speak by full personal experience, as well as by the experience of intimate family connections, I feel bound to protest against the exceptional imputation thus conveyed against the government of a State in which Englishmen are not only cordially welcomed, but are treated with a degree of consideration and confidence certainly not surpassed in any part of the world.

Within the past few years I have travelled thousands of miles through what would be considered the most dangerous part of the country, and from the humblest 'gaucho' up to governors of the respective provinces, have never met with anything but courteous and warm hospitality.

This was at a time anterior to the accession of Señor Sarmiento to the Presidency, during the height of the Paraguayan war, when the interior districts were denuded of the ordinary protection of Government troops, and consequently local factious were uncontrolled. Subsequently there has been extraordinary progress in every part of the Republic. New colonies, English, Italian, and American have been founded, schools opened, public institutions promoted, railways extended, and an International Exhibition decreed for October next.

The Argentine Republic ranks above several important European countries as a commercial customer of Great Britain. Her railways are constructed by English contractors, and I would appeal to Messrs. Brassey and Wythes for testimony as to the reception accorded to their employes. The financial honour of the Government to its foreign creditors is not only unimpaired, but has been such as to set a distinct example to other nations; and so recently as September last, an ad-

dress presented to his Excellency Sr. de la Riestra, headed by Messrs. Baring Brothers, and signed by every leading house connected with the South American trade, bore testimony that fact.

In every country that is being rapidly settled there must be dangers unknown to old communities, but I believe the majority of Englishmen who have visited the Argentine Republic will be found to express a belief that life is more safe in that country than in Ireland, New Zealand, or California, and quite as safe as in Australia.

A strong proof of the unjustifiable character of the present advertisement that the emigration to the Republic is entirely spontaneous. The Argentine Government do not spend a dollar upon it. The people who are now swarming thither go out for the most part at the invitation of members of their families who have settled there and attained prosperity, and who are likely to have more practical knowledge than the Emigration Commissioners in Westminster. The influx comprises no ignorant paupers, and any who are assisted, are assisted solely by remittances from their own friends.

Possibly, since the return of the troops from Paraguay, difficulties may have been experienced such as would result in London or Paris, after the partial disbandment of an army. These, however, could never warrant such an attack as has now been made on the Government of a friendly foreign nation. If exceptional circumstances have operated, and are not to be taken into account, the Argentine or any other government might now fairly publish a notice, warning their citizens not to visit Ireland. It appears that the hostile notice has been founded on some dispatch written by Mr. Stuart, Her Majesty's minister, at Buenos Ayres, to the Foreign Office, who is now retiring from his functions and has apparently considered the moment of his departure an opportune one for such representations.

BRITISH LIBRARY.

There is no better method of obtaining reform in long existing abuses than that of giving them ventilation in the columns of a newspaper, and it is high time that something was done in the matter of our English Library, which has so long been a crying shame to the British residents in Buenos Ayres.

This subject is one of no little importance, considering that the rooms are the only place where our young countrymen can read the English papers and periodicals, and meet together in the long evenings of winter, without the drawback of the somewhat noisy company frequenting the billiard saloons.

Our attention was most strongly and disgustingly drawn to the state of these Library premises on Tuesday evening last, when we had occasion to attend a meeting in the inner room, and there saw more than one unfortunate individual literally over-run with that most loathsome of insects, the 'Norfolk Howard.' Now, this was placed beyond the shadow of a doubt; and what was the result? That two members present resolved never to enter the building again, and one of them is determined to withdraw his subscription entirely.

The whole institution wants a thorough and sweeping reform, either new premises or a complete refurnishing of the present, the whole of the books to be gone through and the old stock to be sold as waste-paper; new life and light to be let into this den and a really pleasant place made out of what at present is so repulsive. We are perfectly aware that all this will cost money, and that the Library is poor, but as there is a will there is a way, if the gentlemen composing the Committee will only put their shoulders to the wheel and not be content like past committees, to leave things as they found them, we are sure they will be more than repaid for any trouble they may take in the matter by the gratitude of the members of this institution.

FERRO-CARRIL CENTRAL DEL URUGUAY.

Montevideo, April 24. Gentlemen: You may see by the enclosed another proof of the miserable mismanagement of this railway. Like a drowning man clutching at a straw, they are attempting another way of conducting the work.

The contract for this little extension of the line was let to Thibaud and Reussen, against I understand, the advice of their engineer, who apparently did not think these persons the right men for the work; and so it has turned out. But the usual custom is to enforce the performance of the contract, and make the sureties liable—if there are sureties—and if not, the Administration must be blame.

It is not to be expected that the prices of these small contractors will be less than the former tenders, and under any circumstances the unfortunate shareholders will suffer, as it appears that the style of work under the so recently as September last, an ad-

rior; however, as the Company appear to have no money, the cheaper the better, though 'cheap and nasty' are likely to be synonymous in this case. 'Hungry dogs must eat dirty pudding.' THE TRANSANDINE TELEGRAPH COMPANY.

A meeting of the shareholders of the Transandine Telegraph Company was held on the 19th inst. in the Commercial Exchange. It affords us pleasure to add that the greater part of the shares of the company have been taken up in this city, and, as there still remains numerous applications unprovided for, it has been resolved to apportion here the 200 shares originally intended for distribution in England, so that the only shares not subscribed for in Chile, will be the 200 reserved for Buenos Ayres.

We have carefully considered the probable results of this enterprise, and we have arrived at the conclusion that it cannot fail to yield a very handsome return for the capital invested.

The determination of the Directors to found a school of Telegraphy for the education of competent operators, cannot be too highly commended, and we shall be very much mistaken, if as soon as the superior direction and skill which is sure to preside over the management of the company's line is experienced, there does not spring up an unanimous desire for the extension to other parts of the Republic of the company's wires.

The number of laborers required for the work in the Argentine Republic is already completed, and they will leave very shortly for Buenos Ayres.

We understand the Directors confidently expect to place us in telegraphic communication with Buenos Ayres in about one year from the present time, and, in little more than that period, with Europe.—Valparaiso Mail, 26th March.

We had a very sudden death in the camp last week. A respectable family of the name of Harris lost their daughter very unexpectedly. the view of rescuing those in distress, and so pleased were the passengers by the conduct of Captain Straunck that they presented him with an address of thanks.

One of the surviving passengers gives the following account of the collision:—"I was lying in the cabin, with my coat and boots off, and heard a tremendous crash. Rushing on deck I found we were in collision. The Normandy had been struck such a blow about the paddle-box that the captain at once saw the ship must inevitably founder. He immediately ordered out the two boats remaining, the lifeboat, it transpired, having been carried away in the collision, and a portion of the passengers and crew thus succeeded in reaching the Mary, all the gentlemen standing back, and making no attempt to get into the boats until the ladies were in them. The captain of the Normandy behaved with the greatest coolness and judgment under such trying circumstances, and the last I saw of him was on the bridge, giving orders as to the management of the boats and the working of the engines, and during the whole occurrence an extraordinary amount of order and quietness prevailed, and the greatest fortitude was shown. The captain of the Mary gallantly stood by, and did all in his power to render assistance, firing blue lights, sending up rockets, and three boats were put out, and the Mary stood by the scene of the disaster for about two hours, but without result, the Normandy having gone down whilst her two boats were reaching the Mary. The Mary herself was so badly injured that some of us doubted whether she would reach port, there being an immense hole in her bow, the iron torn away, and the fore compartment flooded; and had not the bulkhead stood well the pressure put upon it, the Mary must have gone down. As it was, she was lightened at the fore by the corn being hoisted overboard. She arrived safely in the Southampton Water at last, and her captain deserves great thanks for the kindness and attention shown to us, whom he had done his best to rescue from the grave. Many of us passengers came ashore as we were in our cabins at the time of the collision and our hearing the cries when we suppose the Normandy went down."

The Mary has an immense hole in her bow. The Normandy was one of the quickest and strongest constructed mail steamers that cross the Channel, and the force exerted to render her so utterly disabled must have been immense, as she was in first rate condition, and only six years old. During the forty years that the South-Western Company has performed this Channel service so great a disaster has not befallen them.

In Argentine Bank shares 60 sold at 7 p.m. The advices from Rio stilled the market. Exchange has risen there to 214, and sovereigns fallen to 109-90. One English merchant, who shipped cargoes to Rio to take bills there, will make an exchange of 53, and the English bills which he took in Montevideo Comision Fiscal will make the same favorable exchange. The exchange business here today shows a decided rise in the rate. Some bills were passed this afternoon at 4 1/2; drawer, an English house. The bulk of the exchange transactions today were, however, done at 4 1/2, and at 5:15-5:20 on France.

Our special reporter from the market reports every description of produce as firm; 150 to 152 offered for dry hides and refused; some madero hides sold at 153; wools sold at 47 and 68; for fine wool 65 refused; horsehair, high sales from 170 to 185; grease at 15 1/2 in Bordeaux. Mr. Balcarce is now the chief buyer of dry hides, Don L. Martinez having retired for the present from the market. The sale of Mr. John Hannon's wool at 71 was announced; the wool has little burr, but is heavy.

The failure of an estanciero in the Guardia del Monte is spoken of; liabilities not yet stated. The steamer from Rio brings advices of the Arcaqui; she left that port on the 30th. It may interest many of our commercial readers to know the following respecting freights in Bordeaux:—
