THE LIVE CATTLE TRADE.

Colonia, May 8.

To the Editors of the STANDARD.

In reading over your valuable paper issued yesterday I found an article on the Live Cattle Trade, which interested me very much.

I have long watched for the 'denouement' of this trip of the Ariadne, and, I may say, could almost have predicted the result.

I have had a plan in contemplation or some time back, and only waited to hear of the successful trip of the Ariadne across the ocean to offer my idea to the Company.

For eight or nine months, during which time the process of tanning would be going on; they would be taught to stand, to be caught, to be tied, and, in fact, be as tame as those bullocks which are broken in for the cart or plough.

Meanwhile this was being done, tame animals for a trial trip can be bought at prices varying from \$12 to \$16 mpn., such as tame milch cows of from four to six years, and work bullocks after a couple of years tanning.

One thing to be looked to is this, that a fit season of the year must be chosen for the arrival of these animals in England; it would doubtless be best that they get there during the summer months.

Everyone knows that when a bullock has been yoked in a cart for a few times and allowed to go loose again, he grows to a remarkable size.

I am certain that many estancieros would be glad to engage in the tanning of those animals, thereby materially augmenting the revenue of their estates.

At any rate, the plan is well worth a trial. Let not one failure daunt us, let us try once more, and with tame animals; and if it succeed not this, then I may say with you, 'the exporting of live cattle from the River Plate has proved a fiasco.'

This 'Department' was never quieter. Our native novillos have been marched off; a few novillos taken for the use of the soldiers, and some horses from each—but otherwise nothing has happened to disturb the general monotony of camp life.

Since writing the above a party of the 'Reds' has been here and taken six of our best horses. They are not so polite as the Buenos Ayreans; the latter used to ask us to shut in our horses, asking so many, but taking what was given them.
