Jn. Elder arrived Prussians Advancing.

John Elder arrived, with dates to 27th. Prussians retreated from Harre and Dieppe, in consequence of being menaced by French armies.

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The gross receipts of the line were 386,007 8/10 6 1/2, from which subtracting 53 per cent for working expenses, it leaves for net proceeds 181,423 8/10 6 1/2.

The accounts have been examined by the Committee, who report no other difference but 10 tickets from Rio Segundo to the value of 650 8/10 6 1/2, which added to the gross receipts shows a total of 386,073 8/10 6 1/2.

The balance therefore due by Government on the guarantee is 209,820 8/10 6 1/2.

REPORT OF THE INSPECTING COMMITTEE.

In the Boletín Oficial of yesterday we find the report of Messrs. Angel Diaz, Francisco Puig, and Francisco Vivas, the commissioners appointed by the Argentine Government to verify the accounts of this line, for the year ending April 30th 1870.

We may sum up the figures thus:—The line carried 33,624 passengers and 32,680 tons cargo, being an average of 92 passengers and 893 tons daily: the receipts were 386,073 8/10 6 1/2, equal to 105 8/10 6 1/2 per diem.

The undersigned committee, appointed on 19th Sept., to revise the accounts for the year ending April 30th 1870, besides 17 days in May till the opening of the line to Cordoba, report as follows:—The documents for inspection were—1st the tabular statements of each station, 2nd the general statement in summary, 3rd the supplemental traffic report.

The Prussians have called 150,000 of their reserves. The French are supposed to be able to muster million armed men in a month's time.

The Army of the Loire has been reinforced, and sustains its positions bravely. On the 21st December a great sortie from Paris was repulsed; but on the 22nd and 23rd the French succeeded in getting a large quantity of cattle into the city.

New Prussian levies have been called for, as the armies in France are found insufficient. The delay of the John Elder from Bordeaux is said to have been caused by her running down an English steamer, (this requires confirmation), Cassini from London arrived at Rio.

Others clonched their water bottles in hand, but had been unable to remove the cork, and died without being able to wet their lips in their last agony.

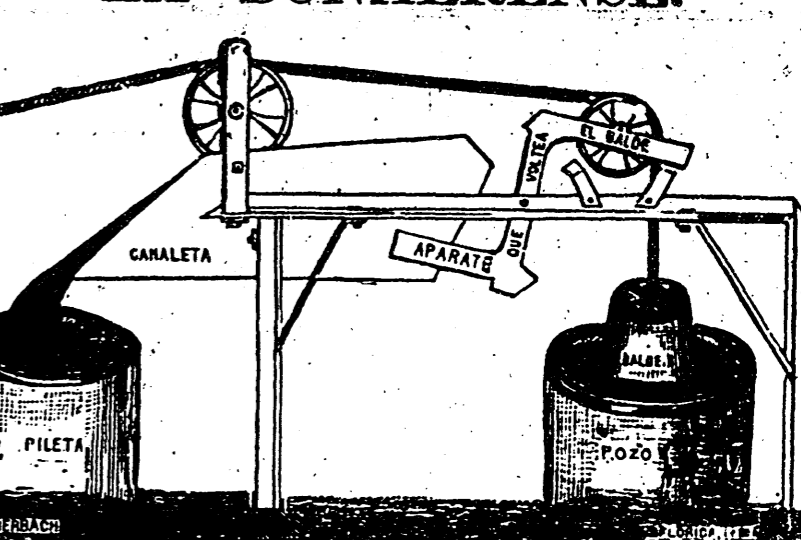
