ined Buenos Ayres who have committed this crime, which through the absence of an efficient police force have apparently avoided detection and escaped with impunity.

The telegraphic institution by its permanency causes all to depend upon it for their business, the care of their interests and matters of private life, and he who suddenly deprives the public of this means of communication, besides the felony he commits against foreign property, inflicts grave injuries on the public in general, which cause great misfortunes and entail a series of troubles to individuals as well as to the Government and public.

Between robbing a letter and impeding the transmission of a telegram what is the difference? Between detaining the train, and cutting the telegraphic communication between two towns, what distinction is there?

In our judgment the difference between the one crime and the other, if there is any, is small in the extreme and a judge would be compelled in view of the results to administer the same penalty to the one who throws a train off the track, as the one who cuts a telegraph line.

Passing to another phase of reflection, the question naturally arises, to what causes, should we attribute these acts which speak so little in favor of civilization and the advancement of the people.

Some 20 years ago ignorance was an apology, but superstitious ideas were not prevalent amongst us at the establishing of the telegraph in B. Ayres, as was the case in Venezuela, Mexico, and even in Chile, and lastly neither the preventions nor jealousies of industrial competition can be alleged in the present case to explain the fact.

Commanders-in-chief there have been who have refused to celebrate agreements for the neutralisation of telegraphs.

Governments there have been who have wished to place the telegraph beneath their especial care.

Editors of newspapers have been known who have openly boasted of their intention to cut the telegraph when it pleased them, and although we are loth to believe it, yet it is a fact, and public opinion endorses the same.

GORTSCHAKOFF. (Concluded.) This territory is peopled. It contains more than 80,000,000 souls.—Plunged in the torpor of semi-barbaric life, it produces the anomaly (when compared with England or the United States) of births to the population of 1 to 22, as against 1 to 38, or in New England 1 to 49.

Fifty years will suffice to people Russia with 140,000,000 people by natural increase alone. But this is not its limit. The Muscovite soil is eminently productive. The genius of the people is fruitful in resources. Wanting in creative faculty, perhaps, there is marvellous aptitude of imitation.

Russia is, in fact, the seat of a young, active, stirring, ambitious civilization; inaccessible to the thought of danger, cheerful, greedy of gain, crafty, morally so supple that it hesitates neither at falsehood nor theft, and achieving every year an advance in the direction it took 200 years ago.

This Empire, placed on the confines of Europe and Asia, presses upon both with an expansive force never felt since the best days of Imperial Rome. It has always been so where the Government was enlightened and the people barbarous, where there was skill in the mover and docility in the instrument.

Against an Empire of colossal proportions, endowed with illimitable expansive power, what are crippled Austria, or precocious Italy, or Great Britain in its dotage, or conquered France, or even exhausted Prussia—what are all those old Powers, whether of overtasked youth or decrepit age, in comparison to this new, active, exuberant, and energetic life of a nation in the gristle of its manhood?

Besides, all great nations have their special mission. To Italy we owe the arts, to Spain the elevation of modern warfare into a science, to Holland the power of industry over nature, to Switzerland the spectacle of liberty successfully maintaining itself against fearful odds, to Germany the spirit of free inquiry, and to France a language which has become the medium of communication over the civilized globe.

What is to be the mission of Russia is conjectured. It can hardly be spiritual. Muscovite genius will scarcely wrest from the sciences their hitherto impenetrable secrets, or open a new era to the Gospel, or work out on a grand scale its own principle of communism.

It must almost certainly be practical. Already she has raised a race of mankind from barbarism and secured for it a place by the side of the Germanic and Roman families. Taking a hint from this great fact, may it not be one mission of Russia to blend together Europe and Asia? Placed on the confines of these two quarters of the globe, she sees them confronting each other within her limits.

The electric wire crosses solitudes, woods, rivers, and mountains, and it is not possible to discover the offender—they will tell us, who level everything by declaring that the case has no remedy, they completely deceive themselves who reason thus.

When an assassination is committed in the country districts, no matter how distant the place may be from the centre of population, do not the authorities who intervene use all the means in their power to arrest the assassin? Surely yes; but the crime is already condemned by law.

not thrilled by the sound of every blow Russia inflicts on the infidel Turk. All this race, extending from the Adriatic Gulf to the White Sea, and from the Erzberg Mountains to the Balkan range, has been tempered any by the sentiment of nationality.

Turks as masters, it links its sympathies and hopes with Russia. It comprehends a third of the population of Europe, and more than half its territory. It numbers the German race three to one. Its bond of unity is language. The sailors of Ragusa converse in the mother tongue with the fishermen of Archangel, and the inhabitants of Prague with the people of Moscow.

"How," asked the magistrate of an Austrian peasant, "has your landlord abused the Emperor?" "He called him a German," was the significant reply.

The Ottoman Empire has lost faith in itself. For a third of a century it has been staggering towards its fall. As an engine of levelling Oriental despotism, its machinery is slowly wearing out. Its instincts are brutal.

The very worst consequences are anticipated from the alarming state of the camp; the drought and locusts have destroyed the pasturages, and the camp in most parts is so bare that it looks as if it had been burnt, yet the stock, strange to say, is in good condition.

This quinta, one of the most beautiful about the city, boasts of the finest orange grove in Buenos Ayres, but already the masons have cut down some of the orange trees to make way for a miserable hotel which an Italian is putting up for a tramway halway.

Within the last few days some very large purchases of wool have been made in Entre Rios, at reserved prices; the wool has to be carted to Concordia, where there is now a very brisk business going on in produce of every description.
