THE SEIZURE OF BRITISH SHIPS.

Mr. William Howe, mate of the Alice, which was seized and sunk near Rouen by the Prussians, gives the following account of the circumstances—The Alice had for the last sixteen or seventeen years been under a contract with a French and English company to supply coals to the gas and chemical works at Rouen.

AUGUSTA OF PRUSSIA.

We print below an exceedingly interesting account of an interview with Queen Augusta of Prussia. It is from the pen of a special correspondent of the New York Times just now returned to Brussels from Hombourg.

pressed with the kindness and charming frankness of her manner. She speaks fluently most of the European languages, is extremely fond of music, and is a liberal patron of the arts.

Queen Augusta occupies one wing of the old palace of the Princes of Hesse and the Princess Royal the other. The building itself is gloomy and undesirable as a residence, and but for the English pleasure-ground laid out by the late Princess Elizabeth, it would have but few attractions for Her Majesty and her daughter-in-law.

The Queen is very partial to France and the French language. In a conversation which I had with her some years ago, I recollect her expressing this predilection in a rather enthusiastic manner: "I cannot picture to myself" she said, "a hope of greater enjoyment than an independent private fortune in Paris and the facility of enjoying the Theatre Francais three times a week."

Talking with me, she remarked that blame had been unjustly cast upon the Emperor as having premeditated and desired the war. "It was due, rather," she said, "to the intrigues and machinations of the different political parties, the Orleansists as well as the two extreme factions, the Reactionists and the Red Republicans."

The Emperor was no doubt censurable for yielding to public sentiment on this point, but it is unjust to visit him with the sole responsibility of the war, seeing that he was dragged into, rather than originated it. So little did we think in Berlin that we were on the eve of hostilities, that the King of Prussia was one of the first to congratulate the Emperor on the result of the "plebiscite."

I ventured to put a question to Her Majesty in reference to the statements put forth regarding Count Benedetti's ungracious treatment of the King. "The facts relating to the Count's reception have been greatly misrepresented," was her reply. "A few days previously M. Benedetti dined with me at Coblenz, on his way to Kissingen on leave of absence. He had been out of health, and was proceeding to that place to take the waters. When I saw him there was neither on his part nor on that of the King the slightest idea that a rupture was probable between the two Governments. I am satisfied from the conversation which I had with him that if the Emperor had any intention to provoke hostilities, or believed in their being proximate, he would not have given M. Benedetti permission to quit his post. The Hohenzollern difficulty was a causeless pretext, and it was seized upon eagerly by the political factions into which France is split, and who had each their motives for provoking a war."

"Does your Majesty think," I asked, "that there is any probability of a modification being effected in the conditions insisted upon by Count Bismarck, as the price of peace?" The Queen replied cautiously, but at the same time in a manner which did credit to her feeling as a woman. God knows," she said, "that the thirst of conquest has no share in the decision of the King and his advisers. Her Majesty then referred to the efforts that had been made to bring about an amicable, and paid compliment to the humane zeal of some of her distinguished citizens, had in the good work.

The French, she seemed to feel, would never forgive the destruction of their beautiful capital and its superlative monuments, and they would not rest satisfied until they had retaliated the dreadful measures to which they would drive their invaders by a prolonged resistance.

"The King seems to bear his fatigues well," I remarked to her Majesty. "Not so well as you think," was her reply. "Whatever may be said of his eagerness to enter upon this campaign, I can assure you that he was not only averse to, but physically ill prepared for it. His health is not of the best, and he has arrived at a period of life when exposure and privations are not good for him. The hardships he has undergone, for I can assure you he has had his share of them, have told so much upon him that he, of all men, should be desirous of bringing the campaign to a speedy conclusion."

I paid the Queen some compliments on the admirable organization of the Augusta Hospital in Berlin, which was organized and is being carried on under her Majesty's supervision, and according to the plan of which most of the temporary hospitals and ambulances in Germany and in the German army are managed. She modestly replied, "I assume to myself no merit for what has been done. Almost all the improvements introduced in our hospitals are borrowed from the admirable examples set us by the Americans during the war of secession."

"Has your Majesty noticed," I asked, "the curious speculations to which the attention paid to the Emperor's comfort at Wilhelmshohe, and the state by which he is said to be surrounded, have given rise in the French and English Press? This inference drawn from all this is that it is the intention of Prussia to send him back to Paris at the head of the three hundred thousand French soldiers who are now prisoners in Germany, in order to re-establish the Empire."

"Such suggestions," replied the Queen, "are very foolish, and have not a shadow of foundation. All that has

been done for the Emperor's comfort has been done by myself personally, and without any ulterior motive whatever. I felt as everyone in my situation must have felt, that a man who has occupied so exalted a position as the late ruler of France could not be treated as an ordinary captive. As to the 'state' by which he is said to be surrounded, it is of the simplest possible character, and very little different from that of any private gentleman. The officers who are with him are prisoners like himself, and they are allowed to stay at Wilhelmshohe as a matter of courtesy. As regards the Empress, I feel the sincerest commiseration for her misfortunes. Certainly no one could have conducted herself with greater dignity, prudence and tact than Her Majesty has done since her exile."

The advices from Montevideo were of the usual nature. General Suarez has returned to the city, an rumor gives that he has resigned. The Government is in a state of crisis—the Blancos advancing, and gold steadily going up, last quotation 13 1/2. There is nothing in the English papers nor Germany about the loan. The Countess came in from Montevideo bringing letters up to 9 o'clock on Friday morning. The mails per Germany are looked for in the morning.

A steamer from Entre Rios also arrived to-day, but strange to say she brought no news whatever about the movements of the rebels, or the Government forces. The Club telegram to-day gave the following—Montevideo, Saturday. Letters just delivered. London sented cow hides 2 man from same Antwerp. Change of temperature expected to free the navigation of the northern seas. Events looked for before the arrival of new forces.

The last advices from Chile are the following respecting the joint stock companies of the sister Republic—Several of our joint-stock companies have presented their half-yearly reports to the shareholders, and the result of their operations is, in general, satisfactory. The National Bank proposes a dividend of 2 per cent, and a bonus of 2 per cent, on the paid-up capital for the half-year. The directors of the Valparaiso Bank propose a dividend of 5 per cent, on the first instalment of \$1,200,000, and on \$400,000 of the second, and at the same rate for 13 months on the rest call of 400,000. The directors of the bank has not been so satisfactory as on previous occasions, owing to a heavy loss experienced at the commencement of the half year. The directors of the Tug Company propose a dividend for the half-year of 4 per cent, in addition to the 3 per cent dividend paid to the shareholders in September. The Banco del Comercio, a bank of commerce established in Gualeguay, has published its annual report for the year 1870. The Directors confess that, but for the aid of Sr. Ambrosetti and other shareholders, the bank would have been compelled to stop. Sr. Medina, the manager, has resigned, and Mr. E. Arango named in his place. Owing to the Entre Riano war the greatest prudence in the management had to be observed, and no further emission of notes has taken place, and notwithstanding that all the other banks have had to close their doors, the Comercio Bank of Rosario has always kept open, but the immense difficulties which the Board had to obtain specie almost stopped all business. The paid up capital of the Bank amounts to 103,400 lbs. Emission 123,422 pats. Cash on hand, 11,492 pats. and 11,792 Bolivianos. The Directors have declared a dividend of 12 per cent, per annum, which is not so bad, taking into account the sad state of Entre Rios. Seventy thousand patacones is the amount already subscribed for the new hotel at the Lomas de Zamora; the capital fixed by the statutes is one hundred and fifty thousand patacones, which appears rather large. One hundred thousand pata. should for the purpose be amply sufficient. The Custom House authorities have been again required to correct the present 'tarifa,' which was so slovenly compiled. Ten per cent. tare is allowed on the following articles in barrels—Salt—bird seed—beans, &c. The steamer Ciano took up in her last trip for the English colony at Canada Gomez 11 cases of agricultural machinery, which have entered free at the Custom-house. The advices from Montevideo were of the usual nature. General Suarez has returned to the city, an rumor gives that he has resigned. The Government is in a state of crisis—the Blancos advancing, and gold steadily going up, last quotation 13 1/2. There is nothing in the English papers nor Germany about the loan. The Countess came in from Montevideo bringing letters up to 9 o'clock on Friday morning. The mails per Germany are looked for in the morning.

A steamer from Entre Rios also arrived to-day, but strange to say she brought no news whatever about the movements of the rebels, or the Government forces. The Club telegram to-day gave the following—Montevideo, Saturday. Letters just delivered. London sented cow hides 2 man from same Antwerp. Change of temperature expected to free the navigation of the northern seas. Events looked for before the arrival of new forces.

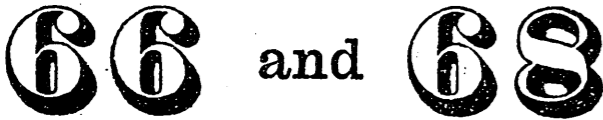
