As we said before, we have no confidence in the Chambers doing anything, and there is, seriously, little chance of the Saladeros being removed unless some fanatics set fire to one or two, pour encourager les autres.

There is, however, a well-founded belief among the citizens of every class, that the conventillos are ten times worse than the Saladeros, and as the Legislature has its hand in, we could wish to supplement the above report by a

3rd Project.

Art. I. All the 'conventillos' at present containing over 50 persons shall be vacated in 7 days.

Art. II. The Municipality shall employ 2,000 workmen to construct a wooden encampment for 50,000 persons at Almagro.

Art. III. The present 'conventillos' shall be expropriated by the Municipality at a fair valuation, and after suitable fumigation &c. be administered by the Municipality as Public Model Lodging-houses.

Art. IV. No room of less than 5x5x3 varas shall have more than five sleeping occupants; and so in proportion.

Art. V. As the conventillos will then admit only 10,000 persons, it will be necessary for the Municipality to build Model Lodging-houses or barracks for 40,000 more, at Almagro.

Art. VI. Working-men's tramway trams will run express (as in London) two in the morning and two at night, for \$20 per month each person.

Art. VII. An Inspector of Model Lodging-houses shall be appointed (salary \$10,000 per month) with a staff of clerks, &c.

Art. VIII. Compensation shall be given to landlords, sub-letters, &c. of all the conventillos now existing; the Jury to consist of Minister Agote, the Italian Consul, and the President of the Topographic Department.

Art. IX. The necessary funds to be raised by Bonds, guaranteed by 1 per mil extra Contribution Directa.

THE SALADERO NUISANCE.

The Provincial Legislature has now before it this question of life or death for the city of Buenos Ayres.

The committee has drawn up its report for the Chambers, but we much fear the Senators and Deputies will absent themselves as hitherto, more especially as it is safer for them to remain at their suburban quintas during the present epidemic.

We are not surprised that the saladeros still find advocates, just as the people of Rome rebelled against the sanitary regulations of the French in 1849, and as the citizens of Madrid tried to defend their unclean habits a century before. The report of the Committee now published shows that the (6) members were evenly divided, three of them being for reforming the system at present in use in the Saladeros, and other three for their total removal.

Deputies Elizalde, Monteseo and Gowland are for the reformation, but unfortunately leave us in the dark as to what reforms they deem necessary; we venture to say that they wish Professor Paigari to draw up another report on the subject, shewing the exact relation between saladeros, Riachuelo and dead fish.

Deputies Aguirre, Marco del Pont and Gandara are for removing all the saladeros before January 1872.

In order the better to explain the difference of ideas in the Committee we subjoin their report—

March 2nd, 1871.

To the Chamber of Deputies:

The Committee has taken up all the projects for disinfecting the Riachuelo, and thought fit at various times to consult the Provincial Government, Board of Health, &c. We have not been able to agree, and almost intended asking for more members to be added to our number, but as the occasion presses we give our projects at foot.—E. Elizalde, J. Monteseo, Ed. Gowland, Dr. Aguirre, A. del Pont, J. Gandara.

1ST PROJECT.

Feb. 14th, 1871.

Art. I. The saladeros, graserias, and mataderos of Barracas must observe the following regulations—

1. Not to throw solids or liquids into the Riachuelo.

2. Not to pour the same into wells or upon the ground, unless for manure, subject to the Board of Health.

3. To remove animal remains in 24 hours.

4. To immerse in bar the residuum kept for fuel.

Art. II. The saladerista may adopt whatever system will meet these ends.

Art. III. All saladeros in other places, or hereafter to be established shall be subjected to the necessary sanitary regulations.

by this disposition, and the assistance it may be found absolutely indispensable to give to such poor families, shall be defrayed by the Executive.

Art. 9. Any infraction however light on the part of public employees of the duties imposed on them by the municipal ordinances or by the decrees of the Executive, shall, independently of rendering them liable to action for damages, be punished with loss of office and disability from holding any other during five years.

Art. 10. The provisions of this law shall cease on the day in which the Health Committee declares that the epidemic at present raging in this city is completely at an end.

GREAT SOUTHERN RAILWAY.

INAUGURATION OF THE BRANCH TO RANCHOES.

Ranchos, March 1.

To-day the trains of the Southern Railway commenced running between this town and the Altamirano Station.

At daylight crowds of people were collected about the Ranchos Station, and at 7.15 the engine started for Altamirano with the acting Justice of Peace and over fifty other persons, including many of the merchants and landholders of the neighbourhood.

At Altamirano, whilst waiting for the return train, rejoicings of every description and demonstrations of gratitude and respect towards the Company, Messrs. Banfield, Roberts, and Grant (the working engineer, and the life of the excursion) were in the ascendant.

At 10.5 the down train from Buenos Ayres to Chacomus brought a large number of visitors, and at 10.15 the first train returned to Ranchos, where Sor. Figueroa, with a large concourse of people awaited its arrival with lively demonstrations of joy.

The party returned to the engineer's house, where an inviting breakfast was prepared for all who chose to partake of it.

Consul Parish's apology to the Municipality and Justice of Peace was read to all, and his health, with English Enterprise, England's Queen, and England's Commerce, drunk with all the honours. Then came Mr. Banfield, an honor to his country, an honor to the Company so much 'his debtor, and an honor to himself for the many noble acts of justice and generosity to all with whom he has had any connection, Mr. Roberts Mr. Banfield's representative on the occasion [three times three]; Mr. Grant, who has made for Ranchos the strongest, most durable, and smoothest piece of railway, not only in South America, but in any part of the world. His health was proposed and drunk several times as a clever man, a good man, a scholar, and a gentleman.

Many more good and loyal toasts were drunk: the Commander of the National Guards, Ramon Seijos, the Editors of the STANDARD, etc.

The meeting would have been much more largely attended did not a 'funcion de la iglesia' interfere; but when the line to the Salado is opened all will be inaugurated together;

EDITOR'S TABLE.

The epidemic continues the sole topic of conversation in every circle.

The official world is solely occupied with it, and projects of good, bad, and indifferent kinds, for cure, prevention, and reform are raining from all quarters. That presented in the Chambers for getting rid of the saladeros next year is the most practical of those which appeared yesterday. The stambede to the camp has assumed smaller dimensions, chiefly because most of the terror-stricken went off in the beginning of the week, and many of those who still stand on the order of their going do so by the advice of their physicians. It was reported yesterday that the epidemic had appeared in some of the camp towns, taken thither doubtless, by the panic-stricken fugitives from town. Rashing in unthinking flight to the camp may, therefore, prove a jump from the frying-pan into the fire; for reliable medical assistance in case of an attack cannot be counted upon amidst the 'fresh fields and pastures new' to which so many are flying for safety. The reports published yesterday show a considerable decrease in the mortality caused by the epidemic. On Tuesday it counted 46 victims in the 24 hours; yesterday the deaths were only about 30, and the number of fresh cases was reduced to 21. These figures would go to show that the worst is over; but the temperature is still so high that any immediate further decrease of the plague cannot, as yet, be counted upon. The fact that the panic is on the wane is very satisfactory; fright does more harm in yellow fever than in that worst of scourges, cholera.

The Republic of yesterday morning announces the return of several hundred Italians to Europe in the Italo-Platense, and states that the reason for their return is that no work could be found for them here. Our colleague is generally correct on points affecting the material interests of the country, but in this instance has been led to an incorrect deduction. The reason the Italo-Platense took home such a number of passengers was that the war in Europe has deranged the traffic on the French lines, and that steamers merely took the passengers that would otherwise have gone by them. Before the vessel arrived in port over 300 of her

berths were engaged. It is but too true that Italian Immigrants prefer staying in the city to a country life, thus overcrowding the town and bringing about epidemics and comparatively low pay for their work; but the fault lies with the Government. Why have we not a Homestead law, as in the States, and all other facilities for receiving and settling new arrivals? If we had, the capital would never be crowded to the dangerous extent it is at present.

The steamer Edward Everett will sail from the San Fernando Wharf for Rosario on Monday next. Fifteen days quarantine will have to be passed at Rosario. The price of a first class passage is forty-two patacons.

The raising of the Yi is now nearly completed, and the port will in a short time be free from one of the most dangerous obstructions it contained. The Yi is being taken up piecemeal, and but little of the hull now remains to be raised.

We have dates from Parana to the 27th ult. The Minister of War received on the 19th the official despatch of General Arredondo announcing the rout of Carmelo Campos and the capture of his six guns.

The Rosario papers announce that a masked ball will shortly be given in that town for the relief of the sufferers by yellow-fever in Corrientes. A subscription for the same object has already been started, the receipts up to the present being nearly 1000 Bolivians. A concert for the same laudable purpose is also contemplated.

It is announced from Mendoza that Major Moyaga lately succeeded in capturing six of the worst desperadoes of Guayama's band. They are all in prison in Mendoza.

We understand that the Municipality is about to contract with Messrs. Rubio & Foley for the whitewashing of all the municipal buildings in town. It is well to see the Corporation opening its eyes to the value of practising what it preaches.
