January 29, 1871. Last night a despatch, dated Versailles, 8 p. m., came at the Prussian Embassy announcing that Favre had signed the capitulation of the forts of Paris, the troops of Paris to remain in the city as prisoners of war.

We are also told semi-officially by the Observer that M. Bismarck has not introduced the subject of the future government of France; neither did he court the intervention of the ex-Imperial Government further than his proposing to M. Favre that, as the Government of Defence could not be recognised as legitimate, he should allow the ex-Regency to be nominally re-instated, so as to endorse M. Favre's signature as an additional security for Germany until the French had through a constituent assembly elected a new government.

Nothing of an authentic nature has appeared concerning Count Bismarck's terms of peace. The Berlin correspondent of the Times asserts that the Germans will ask for Alsace and Lorraine, the payment of a war indemnity of four hundred millions sterling, 300 vessels of war, and the cession of the French East Indian settlement of Pondicherry.

Nothing is known of these terms in official quarters, where it is believed that Germany would not ask them. This feeling may perhaps be referred to the evident intention to reach England through the East Indian cession and the war vessels.

The town is beginning to fill in anticipation of the early meeting of Parliament. We hear nothing of the Conference, but it is supposed it will finish its business next sitting, and that the result will be a compromise by which Russia and Turkey will be allowed to have vessels of war in the Black Sea.
