The Marquis of Hartington, the new Chief Secretary for Ireland, arrived at Kingstown on January 28. The Irish Times says it is now certain that the Prince of Wales and it is hoped, the Princess will pay a visit of some duration to Ireland this year.

The Lord Bishop of Castel was found on the 29th January lying in a state of insensibility on the floor of his bedroom. His attendant immediately sent for medical assistance, and it is satisfactory to be able to state that his lordship was so well next day as to be able to leave his bedroom.

A significant document has just been issued, namely, an address from the Grand Orange Lodge of the Orange Association, which says:—'With the beginning of the year the provisions of the Irish Church Act come into operation. Already we have ample proof that this great measure will exert a healing influence as time progresses, and men become satisfied with the position of absolute equality in their relation to the State.'

It is understood that the Executive is taking steps to ensure, if possible, the better security of life in the county of Westmeath. An additional force of 150 constabulary will be immediately distributed amongst the various stations throughout the county.

On February 1, a meeting was held in Dublin in favour of the release, without the condition of expatriation, of such of the Irish political prisoners as are still in prison. The proceedings were of an orderly character. Resolutions were adopted, protesting against the imperfect character of the amnesty granted by the Government, which was declared to be cruel, inasmuch as it merely changed the sentence of imprisonment to one of transportation.
