BEEF-PRESERVING. NEW ENGLISH SYSTEM.

THE SALADERO NUISANCE.

The Provincial Legislature has now before it this question of life or death for the city of Buenos Ayres. The committee has taken up the report for the members, and by much they are themselves as hitherto, more especially as it is safer for them to remain at their suburban quintas during the present epidemic.

We are not surprised that the saladeros still find advocates, just as the people of Rome rebelled against the sanitary regulations of the French in 1849, and as the citizens of Madrid tried to defend their unclean habits a century before.

After the above report was read the President congratulated the members on the state of affairs as compared with former years.

Mr. Mitchell proposed, and Mr. Rankin seconded, that the above Report being highly satisfactory be adopted; carried unanimously.

SUPREME FEDERAL TRIBUNAL. SR. ANZOATEGUI V. THE PROVINCE OF SALTA.

A few days since we called attention to the remarkable lawsuit between Don Ramon Anzoategui and the Province of Salta for the recovery of import duties levied on the plaintiff's wines and liquors manufactured at his establishment in Jurujuy, and sent to Salta. The duties were enforced by virtue of a provincial law passed by the Salta Legislature in 1866, and the plaintiff paid same during 1868 and 1869, but subsequently sued the provincial authorities before the Sectional Judge for the amount. The district Federal Judge, Dr. Ormaechea, held that the duties were illegal, and ordered the Treasury of Salta to refund the amount.

Art. I. From this date no more saladeros, graserias, wool-washing factories, &c. can be established in the Boca or Barracas.

Art. II. The saladeros &c. already situated there must move before January 1st 1872, as in the law of June 1st 1869.
