DAMAGES IN WAR. The Argentine Minister in London has sent a communication to his Government which we give at foot, relative to the question of indemnities to neutrals resident in a foreign country who may suffer injury in time of war.

There is no principle of international law more clearly defined than the point of indemnities to neutral residents in a foreign country. The Government of the country is wise responsible for injuries done by a foreign enemy, and hence the English residents in France, instead of making their absurd claim, might have saved themselves the trouble by consulting any lawyer, consul, or newspaper editor that was at hand.

It may seem very hard to us, Englishmen in Buenos Ayres, that, if this country unfortunately became involved in war with the Banda Oriental or other foreign power, our houses may be shelled, our goods burned, our cattle carried off by the naval or military forces of the enemy.

The lamentable destruction of life and property in and around Paris still continues. There was a suspension of hostilities from nine in the morning until five in the evening of Tuesday at Neuilly to allow the inhabitants to remove.

Further efforts are being made in Paris to bring about a compromise between the Commune and the Versailles Government. Meetings of representatives of the trading and working classes have been held, at which the programme of the Republican League was adopted.

At Dr. Manning's intercession, says a Berlin paper, Prince Bismarck has warned the Paris Commune, through the Commander-in-Chief of the German forces in France, that should any mishap befall the imprisoned Archbishop of Paris, the general indignation of Europe would probably compel the Prussians to intervene.

Prince Bismarck stated in the German Parliament on Monday that, supposing the Versailles Government were to immediately pay the first instalment of the indemnity, the Paris forts held by the Germans would not be given up until the final treaty of peace was signed.

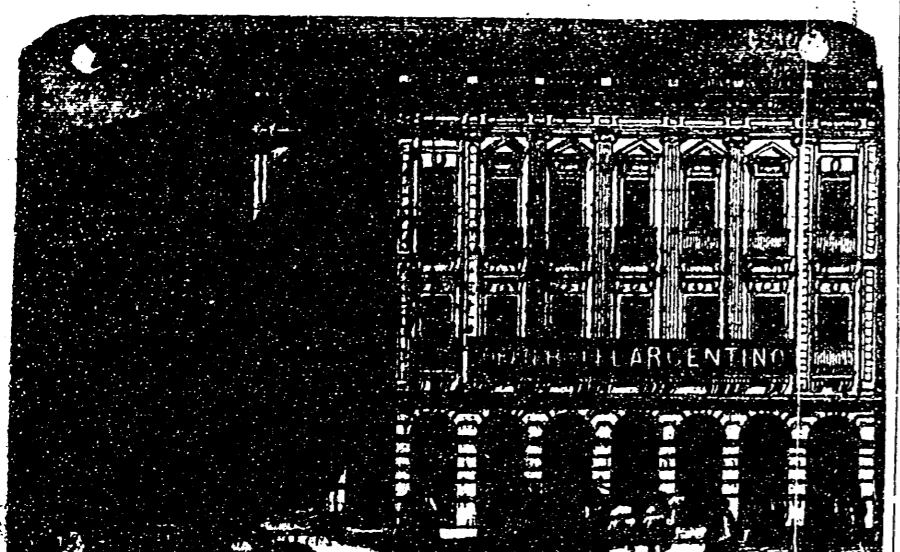

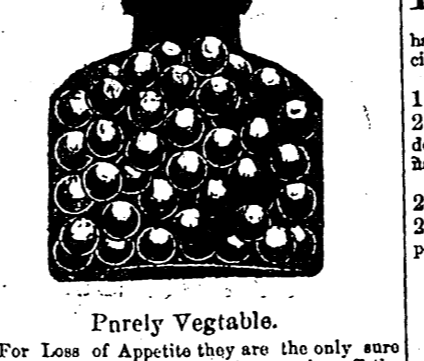
