everything pre-anged a storm, but no one expected the awful tornado, which ensued. About 3 1/2 o'clock a.m. a sudden and awful roar of thunder was heard in the West, and in an instant the Storm Fiend swept over the little town.

There was a large attendance at the English Church on Sunday, to hear an eloquent sermon of Thanksgiving for the cessation of the epidemic, delivered by the Rev. T. E. Ash B.A. The number of the congregation clad in mourning was remarkable, and testified to the severe trial the pestilence has proved to the small British community.

There was quite a demonstration at Rosario last week when the first steamer from Buenos Ayres arrived on the opening of the port. Crowds of people gathered on the mole-head to stare at the 'Republica,' the 'Edwards,' and other fine steamers.

Mr. H. Bankart lately read a paper at the Royal Geographical Society of the Tucumano gold mines, in which he told a very flattering tale to that distinguished body. The gold, he said, was very abundant, and the assays from specimens which he presented with his own hands, yielded on assay from 57 oz. to 6.512 oz. to the ton of ore.

The neglect of the Municipality to pave that part of Calle Victoria from the wooden pavement facing the Club Progreso up to Calle Characota, has resulted in seriously damaging the splendid wooden pavement which has been so admirably finished on the 16th May, and although there was only half a square to be paved by stone.

H.M.S. Immortalite, which was one of the ships attached to the flying squadron about to visit the Plate, is said to have been lost on a mud bank in the harbour of Kingston, Jamaica. Some other war vessels and 2000 sailors were sent to assist her, but could not get her off, or her guns out; her rigging, however, was saved.

The town-house of Dr. Drago, who is at present at Flores, was robbed on Thursday, and furniture of great value taken from it. An Argentine doctor has published a pamphlet on the yellow fever, which we have not yet seen; but it favoured with a copy of it we will review it with pleasure.

In view of the spread of small pox of the Chico and Ortiz Banks, to which purpose special surveying officers are expected from the Hydrographic Department of the Admiralty.

Such is the disorganization on the railways of Paris that 200 francs is openly charged by most of them for a seat, no matter to what destination; this price is alike asked for a ticket to take you a league from Paris, or to the most distant station.

The Cafe Catalanes has opened again, and looks cleaner and more lively, for the liberal use of paint, made while its doors were closed during the plague.

A General Meeting of subscribers to the British Hospital will be held on Friday next at the Bolsa, to receive the half yearly reports and statement of accounts.

It is said in London that the new Licensing bill becomes law, in twelve years it will be impossible to get a glass of 'bitter' in the city of London. The poor Cockneys will then have to fall back on Guinness's XX from Dublin.

Dr. Pedro Rojas, the Father of the Faculty of Buenos Ayres, died on Wednesday last at the ripe age of 81 years. The deceased physician enjoyed a very high reputation in his profession; in early life he was attached to the army, and saw considerable service.

We find the following in a late number of the Athenaeum:—"The marriage contract of the 'Bride of Lammermoor,' has quite lately been discovered at Sr. Mary's Isle, the seat of the Earl of Selkirk. It was evidently unknown to Sir Walter when he wrote his novel.

The forthcoming dividend of the Great Southern Railway will be 18s. per share free of income tax, or at the rate of 9 per cent. with a good balance carried forward. Considering how dull trade was in Buenos Ayres last year, this is a good result.

The ultimate negotiation of the six million National Bond Loan created some little surprise and was conducted so secretly that few actually best informed were not aware of the final settlement until it appeared in yesterday's issue.

The terms of the loan about which there is so much enquiry are— Art. 1. Six millions issued, at 70 net, free of all charges. 2. Six hundred thousand pounds to be shipped to the Plate in monthly instalments, balance to be arranged here.

Nothing done in Government bills. The scrip of the new Argentine loan has suffered a sharp fall of two per cent. The Times in speaking of the yellow fever in Buenos Ayres reports the death of Don Hector Varela, editor and proprietor of the Tribuna newspaper; happily our London colleagues was misinformed.

A decree dated 24th inst. authorizes the Brazilian Navigation Company, organized in New York to operate in the Imperial territory. Mr. W. R. Garrison is President, Mr. J. M. Carrer is Managing Director in this city, and the association has been formed to carry out a contract concluded in June of last year for the conveyance of mails along the coast from this port to Para, a service heretofore discharged by the Companhia Brasileira de Paquetes a Vapor.

The Charges d'Affaires of Great Britain, France, Italy, and the United States of North America, and Germany, in a collective note of 16th March, return thanks to the Peruvian Government for the way in which it has satisfied the claims of their fellow subjects for the damage they suffered during the pillage of Callao in 1865.

By a decree dated 31st ult., the exemption from export and import duties accorded Mito Grosso on the 15th of July, 1869, for two years, has been prolonged for three years, in compensation for the evils inflicted upon that province by the Paraguayan War.

The Enterprise, an American schooner, is stated to have reached the capital of Amazonas on the 21st of February last, on its way to the Upper Paruru River. She had on board a body of over twenty emigrants from Boston, who proposed settling on Bolivian territory under a concession obtained by Mr. Piper from the Government of that State.
