CHEAP LANDS.

A SELLING AN ACRE.

The new Land-law has given great

satisfaction to the farmers, and promi-

ses incalculable benefits to the country.

Many of our countrymen will be the

first to avail themselves of land at a

shilling an acre, a price far lower than

any of the English colonies at present

offers (unless in the case of land grants)

to intending settlers. Suffice it to

say that a few Englishmen clubbing

together can have each 1,000 acres of

land for ever for the trifling sum of

£50 to £60 sterling.

The lands of Bragado and Nueve

de Julio are virgin soil of the richest

fertility, alike suitable for grazing

or tillage; they are quite secure from

the Indians, (the number of settlers

having greatly increased of late years)

and are within a day's journey of the

city; in a word they possess as many

advantages as did the lands of Lujan

or Mercedes 20 years ago. Never

before have lands been offered to the

public at so reasonable a figure, and

now that the good times seem to have

revived for the sheep-farmers this is

likely to give a great impulse to our

agricultural interests. Add to this

that many people, disgusted with the

unhealthy condition of the city, are

meditating a return to a rural life,

fresh air, and longevity.

Formerly if a new comer wanted to

get land he had to buy of private

owners at the rate of 5 or 6 hard dollars

an acre (say one million currency per

square league), or else procure at a

high price through some of the Govern-

ment clerks a right of *enfiteusis* or mere

squatter's privilege. Now he may com-

mence as a landed proprietor with a

very moderate capital, as will be seen

by a computation of the rates fixed by

the new law.
