The Cordoba Exhibition has closed, and in another column our readers will find the list of prizes, in which, as usual, Englishmen hold a prominent place; some of the names, especially in agricultural machinery, are of world-wide reputation, having already figured with like distinction at the World's fairs of London and Paris.

Notwithstanding the prevalence of small pox, the daily mortality has been for some time below the average, and we have well-founded reason to hope that the summer will prove a healthy one. Rain has been pretty frequent in town, but not in the camp. The confirmed good news from Europe respecting produce is consoling to the sheepfarmers, after so many years of trial.

The people of Buenos Ayres from the outset took only a secondary interest in the matter, and it is a characteristic fact that up to the present hour is the only paper (beside the Deutsche Zeitung) which has thought it worth while to publish the names of the successful exhibitors.

At present the Upper and middle Provinces, at present the trade supports various lines of steamers, and the Railway is likely to have a highly remunerative traffic, equal to it not surpassing, that of the Western or Southern railways which give usually 9 to 10 per cent. net profit on the capital.

Tramways, railways and telegraphs continue to engross attention. The wires to Chile will soon be complete, already reaching Mendoza. The overland line from Montevideo to Rio Janeiro was commenced last week.

The various Provinces of the Republic are in the enjoyment of profound peace, except Corrientes where a passing difficulty has arisen with the expulsion of the Governor. Happily there was no blood shed.

An armistice has been arrived at in Banda Oriental, the belligerents to remain 60 miles apart while the terms of peace are under discussion.

Mr. Napp solicits from the Argentine Government a subsidy of £21,000 yearly for a monthly line of emigrant steamers from Hamburg to this country, on the understanding that the fares to be charged will be the same as those from Bremen to New York, and that he brings out 500 passengers by each steamer.

Two new lines of steamers are spoken of from Havre and Genoa. The ideal Italian immigration is as strong as ever: the total number of immigrants arrived last year was 31,000—a high figure, if we bear in mind the four months' plague.

THE CORDOBA PRIZES. The Cordoba Exhibition was in one respect a brilliant success, in another a wretched failure. The immense variety of articles exhibited far surpassed all previous exhibitions, and the number of persons who visited the Exhibition during the 3 months that it was open exceeded 30,000. The ceremony of closing was gone through last week by Minister Avellaneda, and the chairman Sr. Olivera, who pronounced suitable discourses, and in the first days of March the palace and remains will be brought to the hammer, unless the former be previously disposed of as a railway station.

is to be traversed by the proposed line. Starting from the fashionable West-end of our city, it will leave on the left the charming villas and country-house of Flores, and traverse in succession the flourishing townlands of Belgrano, San Isidro and San Fernando.

Paraná, at short distances from the ports of Campana, Zárate, Baradero, San Pedro, San Nicolás, and Las Flores, the most of which it is proposed to lay down branch lines. The country between San Fernando and San Nicolás is thickly studded with estancia-houses, pueblos, locks and herds, about one-third of the settlers being English.

There are also rich zones of English farming land under crops, especially about Baradero, which supplies one city market with potatoes. Between San Nicolas and Rosario are some of the finest estancias in Santa Fe, in the vicinity of Arroyo del Medio, Pavon, Las Piedras &c. The only engineering obstacles are the rivers to be crossed, the rest of the route offering almost a dead-level where nothing is to be done but lay down the rails.

There are 13 water-courses intervening, six of which may be dignified with the name of Rivers, the rest being mere Arroyos: the former are, Las Conchas, Luxan, Arceco, Arcecofe, Ramallo and Del Medio; the latter, Escobar, La Cruz, Cañada Honda, Tala, Hermianas, Pavon and Saladillo.

In order to form an idea of the trade resources of the departments to be traversed by the proposed line it would be necessary to obtain the returns of coasting traffic from the 7 intermediate ports that drain their riverwards, besides the tables of importation at the wool-markets by bullock-carts from that part of the Province. In the absence of such statistics we can only take the population, area &c of the departments in question, as by last census (1869).

This shows that the country traversed is the most thickly settled in the Province of B. Ayres, there being nearly 200 inhabitants to the square league, whereas the general ratio is only 70. If, therefore, the Western and Southern Railways traversing a thinner populated country, have yielded for some years from 8 to 10 per cent. net profits, it is at least fair to assume that the line to Rosario will give fully as much, especially when it is borne in mind that all our Provincial Railways terminate in the Pampas, while the one before us opens up the trade of a port which is the outlet for 11 Provinces.

Before the opening of the Cordoba Railway the trade of the Upper Provinces was represented as follows— Arrivals at Rosario—3,500 bullock-carts and 8,500 mules, laden with 10,250 arrobes, of the value of £400,000 sterling.

Cleared inland—3,800 bullock-carts and 4,000 mules, with goods to the value of £260,000 sterling. Since the Central Argentine Railroad has begun to open up the resources of the Interior the trade of Rosario has more than doubled, and the rapidity of this development is seen by comparing the returns of income on the said railway in Nov. 1871 with the same month in the previous year.

To these may be added Corrientes, with 125,000 inhabitants, which carries on much of its trade with Rosario. The Census of 1869 showed the population of Rosario to be 23,387, but since then there has been a notable influx of immigrants, and we may fairly estimate the present population at 30,000.
