What coffee is to the Brazilians wool is to the River Plate, and yet we could wish to see our statesmen devote as much attention to the latter as the Brazilians do to the former.

Let us for one moment look at the pains which the United States Government takes to supply the people with the most exact information on everything that concerns the industrial and commercial statistics of the Republic.

Can any man in the River Plate today say within half a million of arrobes what the present wool clip of the Plate amounts to?

And after all, in this age of telegraphs and education it is not to be lamented that such primary subjects are totally overlooked.

Where are the Custom House returns of Buenos Ayres for the past year? Lucky we shall be if at the end of the present we get the first half year of the last.

The trade returns now lying before us are of immense importance; they give the whole wool trade of Antwerp for the last eight years, and show with unerring figures the steady progress of the River Plate wool in Antwerp.

It is interesting to see in what proportions the various countries of La Plata are represented.

The above shows that Buenos Ayres wools increased nearly 150 per cent, while Montevideo gave nearly 7-fold, and the Rivers 15-fold, what they shipped in 1864.

Comparing the successive years, we find that in 1864, Buenos Ayres wools were valued at 2,500,000, Montevideo at 1,500,000, and the Rivers at 1,000,000.

By 1871, Buenos Ayres wools were valued at 3,850,000, Montevideo at 2,300,000, and the Rivers at 1,500,000.
