It may seem undignified to assess a market value on our fellow-beings, placing them in some manner on a footing with live stock; meantime no one pretends that this Republic, on looking any country, encourages immigration for purely selfish reasons; and hence we must consider the value of a settler as a machine for increasing the national wealth and products.

In Rio Grande the Legislature gives a premium of 40 milreis, or about the same as Dr. Costa proposes, on each settler, and in the radius around San Leopoldo we find 20,000 Germans, besides 50,000 in the rest of the Province.

BRAZILIAN AND RIVER PLATE TELEGRAPH.

The immediate result of the enterprise will be to place us in hourly communication with Brazil, and meet the demands of the great line between Rio Grande Sta. Catarina and Rio Janeiro which is often interrupted owing to trees falling on the wires and the sleepiness of the officials along the forest route of 1,100 miles.

While Messrs. Clark & Co. are giving the final strokes to the great Transandine Telegraph which will bring Buenos Ayres within five minutes' hail of Valparaiso we have to note another enterprise, just formed in London with a capital of one million sterling, to lay down an ocean cable from Cornwall to Bermuda and Paris, which will doubtless be pushed along down the Brazilian coast to Rio Janeiro.

Thus it is likely that by the middle of 1873 we shall be in contact with Panama on one side and Chile and California on the other. Nay, that before President Sarmiento's term of office expires (Jan. 1874) His Excellency will be enabled to exchange compliments with the Emperor of China, the Foreign Minister at Melbourne and the Queen of the Sandwich Islands, all the earth being encircled in such a bond of amity that diplomatic intercourse will be of the most friendly kind, and the Foreign Departments become more celebrated for splendid hospitalities than either notes or protocols. Electricity will completely do away with red-tape and sealing-wax.

COLONIZATION OF PATAGONIA.

The Senate of Congress has passed a concession of 50 square leagues of land on the Patagonian coast in favor of Mr. Leander Crozat de Sempierre, for the purpose of establishing an agricultural colony on the same. The land will adjoin the concession of Capt. Piedra Buena, having 3 leagues frontage on the Atlantic and 10 leagues depth, with an area of 33,300 acres.

It is desirable that a hundred such concessions be granted in the present session of Congress, for if some of them never get beyond the condition of projects we may be certain that others will come to something and lead to the solution of the problem of so many years, how to colonize Patagonia.

Argentines have already allowed the Chileans to get the start of them by planting a colony at Sandy Point in the Straits of Magellan, which has caused the Chileans to consider themselves owners of those coasts, as they have by their recent notification against vessels attempting to take guano from thereabouts without the permission of the Chilean authorities.

FEDERAL TERRITORIES.

Congress took up on Thursday a bill presented by General Mitre and four other Senators before the close of last Session, to define more clearly the frontiers of the Republic and mark out 11 Federal territories, and the unpopulated parts of the country, to be placed at the disposal of the National Government for colonization and land-grants to settlers. The territories are: 1. Pileomayo—all that country north of the Pileomayo and west of the River Paraguay, as far as Bolivia. Area about 33,000 sq. miles.

2. Bermejo—all that is comprised between the Pileomayo on the north, and the Bermejo on the south. Area about 35,000 sq. miles. 3. Gran Chaco—bounded on the north by the Bermejo, on the east by the Paraguay and Paraná, on the south by the Arroyo del Rey, Rio Salado and frontiers of Santiago (26.15 S. Lat.), and on the west 56,000 sq. miles.

4. Misiones—all that is between the Upper Paraná, Uruguay, Brazil and the 35th degree of W. Long. Area about 8,000 sq. miles. 5. The Pampas—all the Indio country bounded on the north by Sta. Fe, Cordoba and San Luis, (34 and 35 degree S. Lat.) on the south and west by the Rio Colorado, and on the east by Buenos Ayres. Area about 90,000 sq. miles.

6. Rio Negro—the territory between the Rivers Colorado and Negro, from the foot of the Andes to a line 40 leagues from the Atlantic sea-board. Area about 32,000 sq. miles.

7. Chubut—between the Negro on the north, the Rio Chubut on the south and the Rio Colorado and Atlantic. Area about 50,000 sq. miles. 8. Santa Cruz—between the Chubut and Santa Cruz rivers, the Andes and the Atlantic. Area about 150,000 sq. miles.

9. Magallan Land—all that lies south of the Rio Sta. Cruz from the Andes to the sea, including the islands of Magallan Straits and the Tierra del Fuego. Area about 50,000 sq. miles. 10. Limay—all the slopes of the Andes between the Rivers Neuquen and Limay. Area about 22,000 sq. miles.

11. Los Andes—all the mountainous country between the rivers Diamante, Chadi-lefi, Colorado, Lako Urre-lanquen and the foot of the Cordillera. Area about 18,000 sq. miles. The measurements are not given in the project, but roughly taken from a map before us. They make up in all 574,000 square miles or, one-half the total area of the Republic.
