In 1557 Yrala sent Nuffó de Chaves with 230 followers and some boats to found a city in the Iarayes territory, but the latter soon after learning the death of Irala attempted to found an independent province for himself which caused a conflict with the adventurers in Peru. The decision was favorable to Chaves, who founded in 1560 the

city of Santa Cruz de la Sierra. The Jesuits saw the great importance of this river, and having made surveys and explorations resolved to build a city on its banks.

Matorras, Governor of Salta, made an exploration and rebuilt the town of Cangallé. Col. Arias made an expedition by land to the place and descended the Bermejo in boats. Col. Cornejo in 1790 descended from Salta to Corrientes by the route taken by Padre Chorrillo ten years before. Col. 


