The following extraordinary cure of an attack of one of the most painful diseases known—Rheumatic Fever, reported in the Liverpool papers, will interest the Faculty and perhaps other readers:—"The patient, a near relative of the Premier of England, and naturally far from being strong, had a severe attack of rheumatic fever, and it seemed as if human endurance had reached the extreme point, when two of the medical attendants on the royal family, who had the charge of the patient, decided, as a last resource, to have the immersion of the sufferer in a cold water bath. This was attended with the most favourable results. As the heat of the body when immersed increased the temperature of the water, ice was freely introduced to counteract the change. More than 14 days have elapsed since this great and extraordinary dive into the mysteries of the future of medical practice took place, but from the earliest moments through success has been just the fact, and the patient goes on in every way satisfactorily recovering. Sponges bathed with ice water succeeded the full immersion. The patient was in London at the time; but it is said that the use of the cold bath in urgent cases of fever, when despair had already clouded the brow of the anxious parent, was the invention and the adoption, much more than half a century ago, of the late Dr. Currie of Liverpool, as applicable to typhus, but never previously to cases of rheumatic fever."
