JUAN DE GARAY. Yesterday was the 293rd anniversary of the foundation of B-Ayres by the above-named gallant navigator, in the service of Philip the Second of Spain. Great deeds in history are often told in a few words, and the accomplished writer who at present holds the Finance portfolio in the Argentine Cabinet records the event briefly as follows: "Juan de Garay, with 65 followers as resolute as himself, landed on the spot where the Empire City of La Plata now stands, and unfurled the banner of Spain, on June 11th, 1580, calling the place Santa Maria de Buenos Ayres."

The name of Garay is almost forgotten in the city of his foundation, nor is there other memory of him than an obscure street in a muddy quarter of the south end designated Calle de Garay. Even in the schools and the university of this Athens of S. America the hero of 1580 is as little known as the Princes of the House of Orange. In North America the tradition of the Pilgrim Fathers is the dearest in the hearts and homes of the people; and the name of May Flower is a household word, while Plymouth Rock is pointed out to succeeding generations with all the reverence due a spot consecrated by the genius of history.
