Rates have not improved, though a little more activity has taken place in the shipment of tallow and wool, the latter principally by steamer. The salesmen both here and in the rivers have stopped killing, and the demand for vessels will be principally for boats ash in the rivers, and for tallow from this port. Our supply of tonnage still exceeds the demand.

The fine Hamburg steamer Buenos Ayres has brought out fifty passengers. This looks well. Mr. Meine was out to see the vessel to-day: she discharges about 250 tons more. This steamer will sail on Saturday, 19th, instead of Monday, 22nd, as advertised.

The 13th, another Hamburg steamer, entered Montevideo to-day. She comes up here, and then sails for the West Coast. The Leopoldo II. only got off to-day: the river being so low last night she went aground and could only get off to-day.

Captain Kier, the popular Hamburg captain may be looked for next month in his new steamer the Montevideo, 3000 tons. Hamburg friends are pushing ahead.

A sale of mutton sheepskins from the saladero of Messrs. Silgas and Ferrando, Magdalena, has been advertised. The total killing at this saladero for the 'faena' reaches 55,000 animals.

There was some queer news received on 'Change to-day from Corrientes to the effect that a revolution had broken out there.

There is a riot decided to push on the part of the whole of the Bolsa members to get the Board to enforce earlier hours. The matter comes up at the meeting, and it is to be hoped will be passed. At present there is a crowd frequently in the hall at 5 o'clock, and at 2 o'clock in the day hardly a soul in the place, save the brokers around the ring.

It was announced at 3 o'clock that the Cotopaxi had entered, but to latest hour the message with the news had not come.

From our exchanges per Leopoldo we extract the following—
"The Detention of the Parga.—The case of the barque Parga has again been before Mr. Commissioner Kerr, sitting in the City of London (Admiralty Court, on an application for an order requiring the Board of Trade to pay £750 as portion of the costs incurred by the detention of the vessel. It will be remembered that an appeal was made to this Court, and a survey ordered, when she was pronounced to be seaworthy, and Mr. Commissioner Kerr directed her release with £5000 as the extent of their liability. They had sent in an account, and Mr. Hannel, the solicitor to the Customs, who had met them in a very friendly spirit, had offered them first £1000, and then £1200, but that would not meet the costs incurred by the detention of the vessel. He understood that the Board of Trade were anxious to settle the matter by the payment of a lumped sum, but for the reasons he had already stated it was difficult to fix the sum they would be required to pay. In the end an arrangement was come to, the Board of Trade paying £1200 on account of costs, the claims in respect of any alleged breach at Montevideo standing over. The vessel is now on her way to Montevideo."

"A reliable man says that instead of 75,000,000 foot short of the usual amount of lumber, there will be 100,000,000 more than the average run on the Kennebec this season. There is in the river 110,000,000, including the 'old and new logs.'"

"The statistics of silk manufacture in the U States indicate a very great increase. Ten years ago it was in its infancy, and purely an experiment; now it has attained to vast proportions, and bids fair speedily to become one of the most prominent manufactures of the country. The recently published annual report of the Silk Manufacturer's Association contains the statement that 25,000,000 are invested in this industry in the country, and 16,000 operatives are employed, whose wages reach £1,600,000, and the value of whose production is estimated at between £6,000,000, and £8,000,000."

The following respecting the railways in the State of New York is the latest official statement:—"The Brazilian annual report of the Railroad Commissioners shows 22 railroads in the State, representing 1,268 miles of road; the whole capital stock is \$44,344,650, of which \$35,460,117 86 is paid up; the increase of paid-up stock during the year is \$4,468,873 40; the average cost of construction and equipment per mile, \$58,594 12, the highest being the 'Air Line,' which, though only a single track, cost \$106,401, and the lowest the highest New York, New Haven and Hartford, \$10,393 85, the least being the shipping 'Valley Road,' \$37 12. There are 8,656 men employed exclusive of those engaged in construction, or about 13 to every 2 miles of road. There were 10,133,633 passengers carried, and 3,162,743 tons of freight. The gross earnings for the work were 25 per cent. of the capital stock at 11 per cent. of the whole cost of roads and equipment. Eighty-five accidents are reported for the year—64 fatal and 31 not fatal. Only one passenger was killed, and he by jumping from the cars."

"The Brazilian Government wants navigators to buy up a bank outside of the harbor of Parana-guay, which is not shown on the British Admiralty charts, and which several vessels have lately been lost. The following instructions, should be followed to avoid the bank—
"Vessels coming from the north or south, when in the vicinity of the bar, should not approach the bank and nearer than into 63 fathoms water, until the light on Conchas Point bears N.W. (true), and then steer for it until near the large red buoy, which is anchored on the south end of the bank. When at a convenient distance, from the buoy the pilot signal should be made and the pilot waited for. When standing in for the bar pass to the south ward of the buoy and close to it to avoid another bank, which is one mile south from it."

"This notice affects British Admiralty Charts Nos. 520 and 521; US Hydrographic Office Chart No. 23. It is probable that this bank is shown on British Admiralty Chart No. 23, published September 28th, 1870."
