The Leibnitz Mails.

TEST FROM ENGLAND. Capt. Hairy, of the fine new steamer, Leibnitz, which has made such a splendid run of 23 days, favors us with London papers of July 3rd from which we take the following news: London, July 3rd. His Majesty the Shah of Persia proceeded to Windsor yesterday, to pay a farewell visit to the Queen. The royal party left Buckingham Palace at a quarter-past two, and driving up Constitution Hill and through Hyde Park, the Great Western Station was reached at 20 minutes to three.

It is understood that to-day (Thursday) the Shah will visit the Crystal Palace privately, and that on Friday he will go to the Opera at Drury Lane. On Saturday His Majesty will leave Victoria Station by special train at ten o'clock for Portsmouth, where he will embark on board a French steamer to proceed to Clerbourg. The reason assigned for the non-visit to St. Thomas's Hospital is that His Majesty was too much engaged in writing up his diary to afford time for the visit.

In the House of Commons, yesterday, the orders for the second reading of the Real Estates Settlement Bill and the Landlord and Tenant Bill were discharged. The discussion on the second reading of the Monastic and Conventual Institutions Bill, moved by Mr. Newdegate, occupied the whole of the sitting.

A railway from Dongias to Peel, the first in the Isle of Man, was formally opened yesterday, amidst great rejoicings. At half-past eleven o'clock in the forenoon a special train, containing the Duke of Sutherland and the other directors of the company, the officials of the island, and a number of invited guests, proceeded safely along the new line.

Extracts from the Code adopted by the General Meeting of Subscribers held on the 11th April 1873.

XVII. That all Subscribers shall have the privilege of recommending one in-patient annually for every \$500. of annual subscription, such patient to be free of all charges, and that a patient so recommended shall be admitted on presentation of the letter of admission furnished to such Subscribers by the Secretary to the Hospital.

Collectors shall also be entitled to a similar letter of admission for each \$150 collected by them in smaller sums.

XVIII. That in all accidents, cases of poisoning and other urgent cases be admitted at any time without an official order at the discretion of the Medical Officer or House Surgeon.

XIX. That an order from the British Consul, the Chaplains serving on the Committee, or the Visiting Medical Officers, guaranteeing the poverty of the applicant, be sufficient to procure him admission, subject to such arrangements as the Committee from time to time may direct.

XX. That, so far as the Hospital accommodation shall permit, other patients be received on payment of such a daily remunerative rate as shall be fixed by the Committee.
