" For the efficient performance of these two services, it has been agreed to purchase at the valuation made by Mr. Peter Denny, of Dumbarton four newfull-powered Steamers, specially designed for the tiade; two of which, the 'Loopold II.' and the 'Santiago,' are now in London ready for sea, the remaining two being in a forward state of construction. It is also in contemplation to take over, at the valuation of Mr. George Bayley and Mr. Edward Ritherdon, the

Georgo Bayley and Mr. Edward Ritherdon, the four Steamers that have hitherto been so successfully engaged in the River Plate trado.

"The now ships will maintain a monthly service to Chile, in addition to the present departures to the Brazils and River Plate, thus making the sailings to the East Coast of South America bi-monthly.

"The existing lines of steam communication to the West Coast of South America have hitherto been principally confined to the port of Liverpool; but it is well known that very large quantities of the goods now experted from that port are manufactured in and around London, from whence sailing ships continue to be despatched, the burden of which, last year, as shown by the customs returns, amounted in the aggregate to 11,425 registered tons.


