No, the amateur potatoe is not the thing; whatever other roots and vegetables may be.

With reference to the recent accident to the material train on the Central Uruguay Railway, between Florida and Durazno, on which occasion four men were killed and five injured, we are glad to hear that two of the latter have left the British Hospital in Montevideo quite cured, and that the remaining three are progressing very favorably.

We learn from Rio that Mr. Ashbury was to leave that port in his steam yacht, the Eothen, on Monday next, intending to run down the coast and visit Montevideo and Buenos Ayres before proceeding to the Cape of Good Hope, to which place his pleasure trip was to extend.

We wish him agreeable weather for the voyage and an absence of 'pamperos' on the river.

The death rate of the city was not so low on Friday, 8 adults and 15 children having departed. Taking these with the figures of the previous day, however, they give 26 per mil, the usual average here being over 30.

We hear with much pleasure that the Government has appointed Mr. Joseph Atkins Commander-in-Chief of the National Guards at Patagonas.

Mr. Atkins is a son of the late American citizen of that name who lent the Patriots' money to equip Admiral Brown's first fleet in the war of Independence. The new Commander has long been resident in Patagonas.

Although a large addition was made to the building at the close of last season, it is not sufficient, as the place is crowded to the roof with visitors, and eight new rooms, to be finished in a month's time, are now being built.

The proprietors are very attentive to their visitors, the prices are fair, and accommodation good, hence the great popularity the hotel enjoys.
