Mr. U. Houcke arrived to-day from Guardia Monte, reports everything outside doing well as yet sent in. A good deal of wool sold outside at 62-63. Considered a good year out there.

The article in the Pampa to-day strongly condemning the constant abuse of Brazil by the political papers of this city as most improper of conduct by political editors, was much and favorably spoken of. Merchants applauded Mr. Paz for taking up this great abuse, which might embroil the country in a trouble with a friendly nation against which we have no cause of complaint.

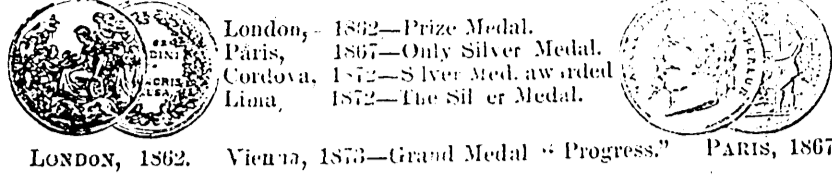

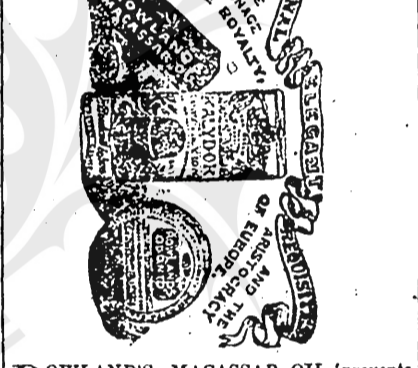
