the passions of the people, the dissolving tendency of democracy, and other strange causes, were in a few years to destroy the new Utopia.

Thank Heaven, such predictions have proved utterly unfounded, but if we would study the greatness of the work begun by Washington we must look at the condition of Europe in that time.

England the traditional home of Liberty, the only country where Habeas Corpus and Trial by Jury existed, where constitutional Government was understood, shone like a bright light among nations.

France was steeped in degradation, from which she was to emerge by a path of bloodshed and atrocity unparalleled in history.

Spain would hardly allow a Protestant to breathe the air of Heaven, and if any died in her territory his body was interred on the sea-shore.

The growth of the American nation has surprised everybody but the Americans. Think you that when Washington and his fellow-citizens were signing the Act of Independence they fancied they were merely laying the foundations of a state that would rival Canada or Mexico?

Olbers arrived with Rio papers of 27th containing telegrams from London to 23rd. Nothing of interest to the River Plate.

To-day we behold a nation of 40 millions of people, whose territory extends from the Atlantic to the Pacific, who have more railways and schools than all the rest of the world collectively.

So it may safely be predicted that in thousands of years to come the Great Republic will still be the wonder of all other nations. Because it is built upon the Heaven-sent doctrine of Civil and Religious Liberty, that throws its rays in all directions to the uttermost bounds of the globe.

Perhaps if old Admiral Brown were alive he would not make much fuss about the new gun-boats. On the contrary, he would feel dissatisfied that they are inferior to Brazilian war-jessels, and in all the flutter of rejoicing over the 'Uruguay' and 'Parana' would say to his adopted countrymen—

"My friends, you forget the time when I brought into port a dozen captured vessels of the enemy, when I swept the seas with my colors nailed to the mast-head, when I carried our victorious arms from Callao to the Indian ocean, and shewed Argentine sailors how to win death or glory on the element that once we called our home."

The official visit of the Minister of War to the 'Uruguay' on Thursday is thus described by the Prensa.

"At 2 p.m. the Minister accompanied by Col. Bustillos, port-captain, L. Col. Soler, inspector of marine, L. Col. Guerrero of the 'Rosales,' Major Benetti, inspector of roads, and various naval and military officers, left the Mole, attended by 3 launches full of sailors in parade dress, passing close to Pavon and Rosales, which fired the customary salutes, and pulled up alongside the Uruguay at 2-15, the commander, officers and crew being drawn up to receive His Excellency.

"The Minister addressed Captain McConochie in English, and the latter having presented his officers proceeded to show the vessel to His Excellency and suite. Among the latter were some 'old salts' who expressed themselves much pleased with the gunboat and her appointments.

"Capt McConochie, who is a Lieutenant in the British Navy said he was engaged to bring her out and hand her over to the Argentine Government. He spoke well of her sea-going qualities and said he came mostly under sail, making 9 miles an hour and even 10 with a fair breeze.

"The captain considers her peculiarly adapted for river service or fighting, adding that she is as tight a gunboat as has ever been turned out of an English arsenal. The officers' cabin is 64 by 8 feet, with berths all round, the woodwork being polished cedar, with blue-and-white curtains, and oak furniture.

"Two huge 44-ton guns are mounted on rails that enable them to be wheeled round as required, firing 100-lb. conical steel shot 12 inches long; the range is nearly 3 miles, and at 400 yards distance the shot will penetrate a 4-inch iron plate or 18-inch plank.

PARIS GOSSIP.

(From Our Own Correspondent.) Suicide decimated Roman Society; it killed those whom the Cæsars permitted to live, and enuuf invaded the happiest homes. Yet M. Pillet comprehends these signs and their shades, without over permitting himself to lose the thread of his allocation.

The Fine Arts Exhibition has opened, and certainly in the number of pictures no annual display has ever surpassed the present. In the 'Salon d'honneur' is an equestrian portrait of Marshal MacMahon; formerly the portrait of Thiers was suspended in the same place; it is the nail allocated to Presidents. There is another painting intended to make a sensation, but which the crowd looks at with indifference—that of the Prince Imperial. It is in mourning, with the cordon of the Legion of Honor—for he picked up a ball near Spionhera; beside him is a bouquet of violets, half-veiled with gauze, and one of the volumes of the 'Correspondance de Napoleon I.' Remove the accessories, and the boy-figure remains without color, or expression, and anything but calculated to kindle enthusiasm.
