In consequence of the severe cattle disease which has committed such ravages in the River Plate, especially in the Portenos of the maternal beststock, the government of Brazil has ordered measures of precaution to be adopted along the frontier of Rio Grande do Sul, to prevent the introduction of the disease.

By decree of August 5th the Imperial government affixes the 700,000 guarantee of the Province of Pernambuco, upon \$50,000 per kilometre, conceded to the Recife and Limoeiro railway, with a branch to Nazareth.

The total of guaranteed capital is limited to \$5,000,000 and the time of guarantee to 30 years. As regards purchase of the line, it may be effected after 15 years, and the price, in case of non-agreement, shall be regulated by the average of the net income of the preceding 5 years, with consideration of the value of the works etc. at the time.

The American brig Frank Howard, from New York for Rio Grande do Sul, landed at Pernambuco, August 29th, the crew of the American coal ship Sierra Nevada, destroyed by fire Aug. 13.
