RO. NEGRO. COLONIZATION PROJECT.

The Minister of Justice of the Argentine Republic, Mr. William Rawson, in name of the Government, or one party, and a special committee of the Welsh Engineers Society of London, have sent a personal letter to Mr. Alfredo Vizcaya, High Sheriff of Corrientes, and Robert John Parry, of Maita Castle, Wales, on the other part, have agreed to conclude the following contract:

1st. The Welsh Emigration Society shall receive from the Argentine Government \$100 to 600 families, according to what they establish in the territory of Corrientes, in the Argentine Republic.

2nd. The Argentine Government grants to every 200 families a municipality of 10,000 ha., the amount of which may be increased to 15,000 ha., to be devoted to culture and public works, such as roads, churches, schools, etc., and for other public purposes; the remaining half to be distributed among buildings, plots, either to be given gratis or for the rental amount of the colony.

3d. In addition to the 25 ha. of land of each family, the Government, in accordance with its moderate terms, will grant in areas of five regalies for every 200 families, adjacent to the respective municipality, to be divided among them.

4th. In case the colonists require more land, they may apply to the Government for additional plots, in accordance with the moderate terms of the contract.

5th. Any mines of metal, coal, or minerals which may be discovered shall belong to the finder, in either individual or corporate "sovereignty" as determined by law.

6th. The general management of all colonies, their administration, shall be vested in a commissionary government appointed by the National government, the number, and for the period, directed by laws to be provided for territorial jurisdiction.

7th. The municipal administration shall be exclusively to the colonists, in accordance with their own regulations.

8th. The colonists shall be exempt from all taxes, except those imposed by law, to defend themselves, until their first year.

9th. When the population of the colony shall have arrived at the number 10,000 souls, it will enter into the status of a town, and be entitled to a coat of arms, and such other privileges as will be granted to it at the same time its inhabitants shall be definitely numbered.

10th. The National Government, seeing the distance and situation of the colony, will furnish the armament of a company of engineers with 4 pieces of artillery, 500 fusages Indian rifles, 1000 cartridges, 300 tents, horses, 80 cattle, cows, and 3000 sheep.

11th. This society will give timely information to the National Government, of the distance and situation of the colony, when the first batch of colonists may be expected to arrive at the port of Bahia Blanca, in order that the National Government, in accordance with the previous article, may be sent to it, or any other point indicated, in time to meet them on their arrival.

12th. The present contract shall be submitted for approval to Congress.

Gentlemen.—In your paper of 14 instant, under the heading of "Africa," Mr. Alfredo Vizcaya—wherein you state that "the King of Portugal has sold to the King of Brazil a large tract of land that borders upon land"—state a circumstance to the effect that "I" (in the character of Mr. Alfredo Vizcaya) had written to him in England:

"This is simply untrue. I never heard of such a thing. I am told, for certain, that there is no such place as Africa, and that the natives of that island have been sent to the University of Oxford."
