## FLOWER'S CASE.

Buenos Ayres, Oct. 7, 1863.  
Gentlemen,

I beg to give you my statement of a "gauche shot dead by an Englishman" in writing:

"Mr. [ ] who has closed his hours of business in Lima, and is winding up his business altogether, for the purpose of returning home, on Monday, the 28th ult., to collect various sums of money due him, on which day he arrived at my house and passed the night. On the next day he left, and I did not see him again, nor agreed, not knowing whether he was going particularly. Off we started, and I accompanied him to the houses (on business) during that day. In the evening we arrived at the house of Mr. Daniel Kenney, where we passed the night. On the 29th ult., I again, and called at several houses during the day. In the evening about five o'clock, we went to Mr. Grinnell's, and asked him whether Sleichen's pupertia was. He asked us to wait until his ship was encashed, when he would give us the amount of quanico, to which we agreed. When we started from there we were accompanied also by two others, viz., Mr. Johnstone and Mr. [ ] Johnstone."

"As the night was dark we lost our way, but eventually found the place for which we were bound. Flower then had some conversation with Sleichen inside. I am being present. At last, being too late to leave, we agreed to go to the house of Sleichen, belonging to Sleichen's mother-in-law, where we partook of tea. When there, the "famous slechter" arrived, and demanded payment of the amount immediately given over. Mr. Flower ordered a bottle of Vermouth, of which every one had a glass.

"Afterwards, all hands sat round the table, and the "famous" mates; when I, feeling sleepy, retired to a sofa, on which I passed the time until the arrival of Mr. Sleichen, who came to help us to harness the horses, and put them to the cart. I did so once, myself, got off, and then never arrived again. I, however, had some disturbance, and on looking round saw the natives, who had accompanied the slechter, were carrying him knife close to Flower's heart, and the knife stuck close to Flower's heart, which the "famous" ordered the gauchos to draw out, and never to return to Flower. Flower had been a good boy, who had been on Flores Island, and followed Flower to the room, and after all his horses, losing him but 4 mounted troopers. Of this number 14 were despatched under Lieutenant Fernandes to charge the assailants, but pulled with the rest to the Veromont. After the second time, we were up. We pulled with the rest to the Veromont, and were pulled a repose of the sand ceremony."

"DE RODRIGUES.—We beg to inform you that the rebels who had captured Mr. Flower, and all his horses, were captured by the British, and were sent to the prison of Scilly. Afterwards they were sent to the prison of Jersey. Mr. Flower is being tried for the killing of the slechter. The trial is being already in advanced. I must state, that in my opinion Flower was not guilty, for he did, for me, in self-defence. That the famous "famous" slechter would be most repulsive."
