#### M. RIESTRA'S MONETARY

Our noted financier, M. Riestra, has at last brought forth a project for the redemption of the paper money, at the rate of 400 dols, per ounce, or 25 dols. per patacon.

On a careful perusal of M, Ricstra's

letter to the Legislature, explaining the working of the proposed law, we feel satisfied that it is about the best scheme which has ever been introduced. We regret to remark, however, that it is very complicated, and lacks simplicity.
