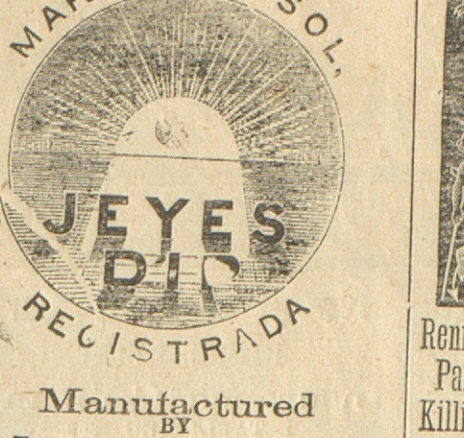

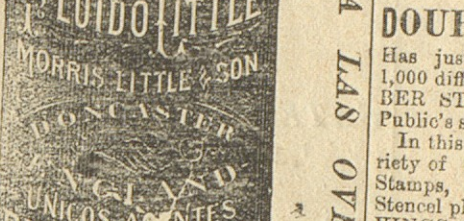

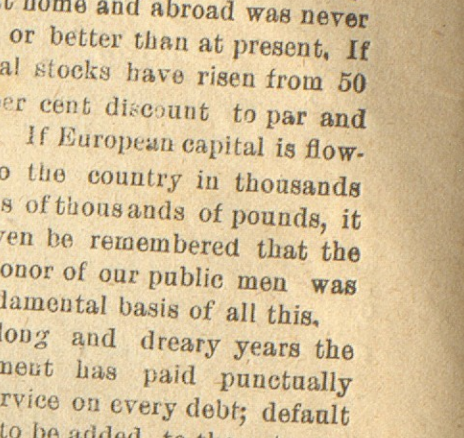

LATEST FROM THE U. STATES

New York, 16th. In an important leading article upon the Irish question the Herald says:—Let a good understanding between England and Ireland be compassed by a reform in the existing relations between England and her dependencies.

The English Parliament represents not so much the people of England as the customs, traditions, and vested rights of the small monopolies called by roughs and the large landed interests. A true Parliament, one representing the English-speaking world, would be an imposing body, but such a Parliament should not represent Calne or Liskeard, Radnor, or the Universities of London, Oxford, and Cambridge.

It should represent English colonies and colonies upon the principle of American representation—that is to say, every member of Parliament would be chosen as the representative of so many thousands of English subjects. Such a Parliament, coming from Australia, Canada, New Zealand, Cape of Good Hope, from Ireland, and from English dominions in Europe, would have an Imperial power. Under the system of independent self-government like that we give to Massachusetts and Texas or California, Ireland would be as one State, and have all the benefits of independent government like that we enjoy in New York.

FRENCH CONCESSION TO CANADIAN SHIPPING.

There is one important feature of the proposed new French commercial treaty with England which, singularly enough, in the various discussions of the subject, has been overlooked. We refer to the reduction of the duty on Canadian-built ships to a nominal figure, as if to enable France to obtain a larger share of the ocean-carrying trade than she at present commands.

What Mr. Galt really contended for was a special or conventional rate for Canadian ships, such as existed for English bottoms, in order to afford Canadian craft an advantage at least over vessels built by nations which had no tariff convention with France.

The Montreal Herald, we observe, attaches great importance to this concession, and in forecasting its results, says: "Our friends at Quebec, St. John and other great shipbuilding ports will now have the opportunity to sell to France such wooden ships as she may require without the payment of oppressive duties."

For our own part we are disposed to look upon the concession as wisdom in recognizing the wisdom of permitting French merchants to purchase vessels wherever they choose, in the cheapest markets, rather than as conveying any practical advantage to shipbuilders at Canadian ports, who are prepared to supply wooden vessels only.

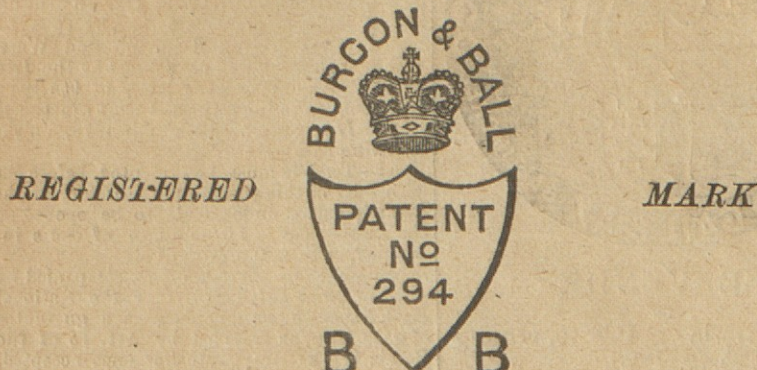

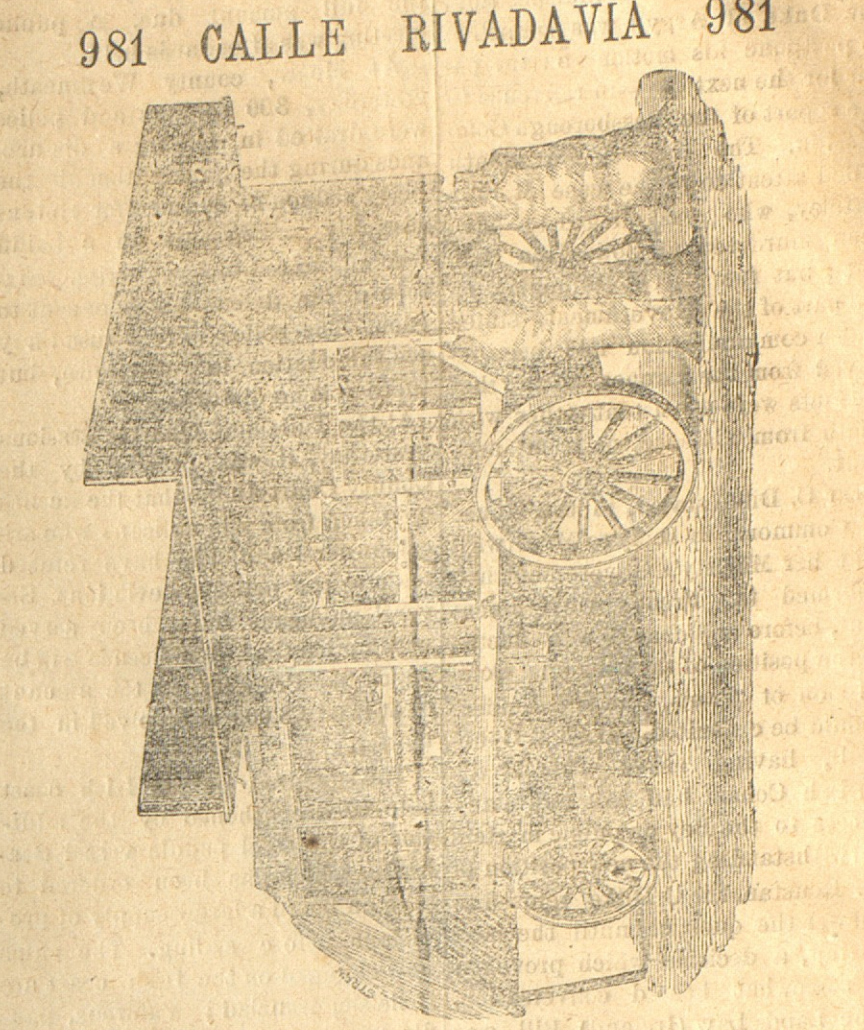
