Attempted Assassination OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES

Philadelphia, July 2nd President Garfield, in Washington, went to the Baltimore and Potomac Railroad Station to take the Pennsylvania Railroad train for N. York

On arriving at the station he was shot twice by a man described as a discharged Government employe, who is insane. The assassin was arrested.

The latest Washington reports indicate that the President is in a dangerous condition. He had gone to the station to begin a two weeks' tour through the Northern States

in which he was going first to Long Branch, where Mrs. Garfield would join him, thence to Irvington on the Hudson River, above New York

where they would be Mr. Cyrus W. Field's guests till Monday. President Garfield was shot in the ladies' room of the railway station, immediately after entering the room

arm-in-arm with Secretary Blaine, who, hearing two shots, rushed in the direction where they came to arrest the assassin. Before reaching him the Secretary returned to the President, who was prostrated. Both shots took effect, one in the right shoulder, the other in the back, near the kidneys. The Surgeon General, Dr. Bliss, and Dr. Purvis, the latter a colored man, were quickly in attendance. They probed unsuccessfully for the balls, and then ordered the President to be conveyed to the White House. By this time the streets were thronged with excited crowds. Two companies of regular troops were ordered from their barracks to aid the police in preserving order.

The shooting was done in the presence of about 50 ladies, who were awaiting the train. The pistol used was of the heavy calibre known as 'California bulldozers'. The President was removed to the White House and made as comfortable as possible in his chamber, and all persons were excluded from the grounds. Immense crowds surrounded the enclosure, anxious to learn particulars. Great sympathy is expressed for the President, with threats of lynching the assassin, who has been taken to Washington Gaol.

A strong guard of troops and police surrounded the gaol, threats having been made that the mob might attempt lynching, though nothing of the kind has yet been indicated. The prisoner is 30 years old, 5ft. 5in. high, and is supposed to be of French descent. He weighs 125 lbs. Intense excitement prevails in all American cities, immense crowds surrounding the bulletin boards anxious for news.

Guiteau before shooting the President prepared the following letter, which was taken from his pocket by the police—

"To the White House." "The President's tragic death was a sad necessity, but it will unite the Republican party and save the Republic. Life is a flimsy dream, and it matters little when one goes. A human life is of small value. During the war thousands of brave boys went down without a tear. I presume the President was a Christian, and that he will be happier in Paradise than here.
