Mr Harben and associates have offered to the government to organize a foreign company to construct a metre guage railway between Rio and Cuyaba, via Goyaz.

On the 20th the 1st section of the Santa Izabel do Rio Preto railway was opened to traffic. The total length of the line, which runs from Barra do Pirahy to Santa Izabel do Rio Preto, will be 80 kilometers, and the section opened measures 25 kiloweters. A projected prolongation would carry it to Lavras, in Minas Geraes, where it would reach a navigable part of the Rio Grande. The S. Izabel do Rio Preto line is expected to cost 3,800:000\$ and has 7 ojo guarantee from the province of Rio de Janeiro.

The president of Minas Geraes has sanctioned the bill giving 7 per cent provincial guarantee to 700;000\$ capital of the projected railway from the Volta Grande station of the Leo. poldina railway to Aventureiro. The district is reported to be very fertile and it is said that 400:000\$ of the capital has been subscribed by planters in it.

The Gazeta de Noticias, also, believes that the government has given instructions for negotiations, in Bolivia, in regard to the construction of the Madeira and Mamore railway and to the utilization of the Bolivian navigable rivers whose waters flow to the Madeira.

The Argentine explorations of the Bermejo have shown that it will give very little assistance to the efforts of the Argentine government to direct the trade of Bolivia into Argentine channels.
