They seem to be in contention of the kind seen at Washington, and the New Yorkers are unanimous in condemning the use of anything but moral pressure to restore peace on the disengaged West Coast. Chile is holding from her line of action during the war, about the last power known that would allow this kind of argument to prevail with her; but North American diplomats have persuasive powers of the very highest order, which we have lately seen triumphant in the settlement of a thirty years question between the country and Chile, and we are not inclined to hope that Messrs. Bancroft and Prescott will be able to give a more peaceable turn to West Coast affairs, although their opponent is simply to induce her to withdraw her accredited Envoy to act together instead of contradicting each other.

The laudable deeds of Gen. Kilpatrick will simplify this mission, and perhaps lead to the success of the greater one of bringing about peace between Chile and Peru without the latter losing any territory. The position of the United States in America is very much mischievous.

Differences between independent diplomats of the same nation are a bad effect. There have been sent a special envoy to each, with instructions that they are to do their best to re-establish peace between the belligerents."

Chilian Minister in Washington telegraphs Prescott and Blane to first to Chile and afterwards to Peru, to study the situation among the American Ministers to secure the harmony. There is no hostile feeling whatever towards us.

An agricultural labourer, for instance, arrives in the Santa Fe Colonies with a wife and two or three boys, and, after arranging about his concession of land, agricultural implements and tools, begins working. In the course of a few years he finds, if he has been industrious and successful—which they generally do—that the ordinary concession of 33 acres is getting to small for him; his sons having grown up, and he himself becoming a man of business and a capitalist, if only on a small scale. He then begins to think of taking a larger piece of land; but which he cannot get cheap, unless he goes some distance inland. In order to be able to do this, in the only likely way of giving a good result, namely, by looking after it himself, he writes to some brother, cousin, or other relation in Europe that he thinks will do, sends him the money necessary to pay his expenses out, and offers to put him in possession of the first concession for a certain sum payable in annual instalments with interest, or agrees to work the land on share with him, finding the necessary tools, implements, seed, carts, animals &c.
