Nothing, or next to nothing, was spoken of yesterday but the Star Chamber business at Montevideo. We give particulars in another column. The bottom of this horrid affair, if it is ever got, will reveal strange things, but it is more than probable that it never will be got at. The only thing certain is that Banda Oriental will have to pay dearly for the facility of its police officials.

The victims ask only £3,000 each, but 'quite safe' if the Foreign Office at Rome will be content with any such sum.

The police figure very badly indeed in the case of the arrest of the Courrier's reporter, and the sooner Mr. Paz issues an order of the day that will put a stop to such brutality the better. The public learned yesterday with the utmost indignation and astonishment that M. LATEST FROM THE SOUTH.

General Roca, Jan. 30th.

When I met you in Patagonia on your recent trip to the South I promised to send you a line now and then from this out of the way region, and here it is.

There is not much news in it, but it will, perhaps, be a novelty for your readers to see anything from this unknown spot. I will confine myself to the present to a brief description of the town of General Roca and in future letters will tell you all about the soil, what it is best suited for growing, etc.

This town is built on a level plain on the north bank of the Rio Negro, the dense fringe of willows on both sides giving it a picturesque aspect. It is fully 300 leagues from Buenos Aires and was founded by Colonel Don Lorenzo Winter with the 5th Cavalry, in September 1879, on a spot which the Indians called Fiso-Meno-Co (shower-bath).

The town is well laid out, like a chess board, with two very pretty 'plazas,' one of which has beautiful trees and a handsome pyramid in the center, on which a statue of President Roca will be placed. The footways are all macadamized, and it is intended to do the same for the streets, as shingle is abundant about here.

There are 300 houses, almost all of brick and whitewashed with chalk which is also plentiful. We have 17 shops well supplied with everything, especially in comestible line, some of them having an invested capital of 300,000 to 400,000 p, a cafe, 4 bakeries, two carpenters' shops.

At a league from town, Mr Cortina, a prominent trader in it, has an estancia on which some European families are settled, with all the necessary implements and machines for farming and cheesemaking. These families are the nucleus of a future colony, as Mr C. has already applied to the Immigration Office for several more families.

The population of the town is about 1500 souls, half of this number being soldiers, the rest civilians, in 200 families. The climate is dry and healthy and the seasons are mild. Every soul in the place is in rude health, and the 'bovina' is almost unnecessary. Don Juan Recalde is the Juez de Paz, an intelligent and progressive man, whom many towns would be right glad to have as their Justice; there is a Municipality to help him. There is a Public Library, a Primary School for boys, and we shall soon have one for girls.

Mr Editor, the people here will have much cause to be grateful to you if you will bring the influence of your popular paper to bear on the Government and persuade it to send down here some of the thousands of immigrants that enter the Republic every month; they are certain of a most prosperous future here.

The thing was precipitated by the inevitable man in the case, and now that a half dozen versions are current, the discriminating public has choice of the matter of fact and the more highly-spiced accounts. Mr West's daughter has the same right to the social standing as the children of Mme Patterson-Bonaparte, the fact of family recognition and sanction of the marriage being the only thing on which a point can be made, and the young lady's arrival in this country will soon test the public opinion.

A NEW CABLE BETWEEN NORTH AND SOUTH AMERICA. Telegraphic communication between North and South America, which has been carried on in a very roundabout way, is to be made more direct under a scheme originating with Jay Gould, who is at the head of the American Cable Company.

It has been known that Gould sought to get a concession for laying a cable to Brazil, and the Rio de Janeiro Journal de Commercio announces that Mr Gould's plan is to lay a cable through the Bermudas to St. Thomas, thence in unequal curves to Paramaribo, in Dutch Guiana, and from that point to the city of Portaleza, the capital of the province of Ceara, in Brazil. The cable has been ordered and the Brazilians are waiting anxiously for the completion of the line.

Communication with Brazil and the South American republics is now carried on by way of England; and the cost is about \$5 a word to Rio de Janeiro. English companies have a cable from Pernambuco to England, and control the lines down the coast of Brazil to the Argentine Republic, across that republic, and up the western coast of South America, through Chile, Bolivia and Peru. For some time the Brazilians have been dissatisfied with the service of the English companies, and when last summer Mr Gould applied to the Brazilian Government for privileges equal to those the English companies enjoy, he was fortunate in hitting upon a time when the English companies were particularly aggressive in trying to force communication over their cables to Buenos Ayres instead of over the land lines. He was also fortunate in interesting officers of the Brazilian Government in the project. His cable will shorten the distance between New York and Rio de Janeiro more than two-thirds, and the Brazilians will not be confined to the use of one line.

After Mr Gould's cable is laid, communication can be had with Chile and Peru by two routes, whereas now a despatch to our Minister at Peru has to go to England, thence to Pernambuco, thence down the eastern coast of S. America, and, after crossing the continent, up the western coast. It has been said that Mr Gould wanted to purchase the Central and S. American Telegraph Company's cable, but he may be satisfied with his cable.

There is to be a telegraphic convention in B. Ayres during the exhibition there next month, and the indications are that the Emperor of Brazil will attend, in order to promote a better understanding of the telegraph's business in the republics. The lines of Brazil and at Ceara, where Mr Gould's cable is to land, and the desire is to have the land lines under a perfect system for better communication with the U. States.—N. York paper.
