THE JACOBI OUTRAGE. The Volpi and Patroni affair is the most serious that has occurred

in these countries in our recollection, and he would, indeed, be a wise man who could say when or how it will end.

Viewed in a political point, this truly shocking affair will be productive of some good, since it will free Montevideo from the Jacobins,

who have ruled to rule that Italy, and who have brought Republican Government into such odium that even the people

of Montevideo preferred a Dictatorship to the fact of constitutional Government going on, perpetrating crime, legalising torture,

and forming a standing menace to every one but the pampered soldiery, whose bayonets ruled the land.

The interests of humanity at large, and of South America in particular, are too great to be trifled with

any longer by these wretched hodge-podge Governments that Montevideo has so long suffered from.

The hour has arrived when redress is at hand. Montevideo should and ought to have a respectable Government.

We wait some representative foreigners in the Oriental Cabinet, and it is to be hoped that the present affair will lead to this result.

We give at foot the following particulars concerning the Volpi and Patroni outrage. The details are very repellent, but must be published to expose those villains

in the broad glare of the nineteenth century, and to show that even the blackest epochs of the Middle Ages, Volpi and Patroni have not suffered in vain, they will redeem the Banda Oriental, and Argentines must join foreigners in that much needed redemption.

The following are the papers— SWORN DECLARATIONS. In the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty two,

we were photographed in the patio of the Policia in a group, with lions on our legs, in presence of an immense crowd of people.

Shortly after, some men I did not know came in, I took them for subordinate police officials.

They asked me, "where have you hidden the money?" I said I did not even know what I was accused of,

and they told me of being one of young Betancourt's murderers, in Calle Juncal.

To my protestations of innocence they replied, "All right, we'll soon make you tell the truth."

Some time after three men, one dressed as an officer and another who I afterwards learned was Larraza, entered

and again asked me to confess my guilt. As I again declared my innocence, they at once applied to all the torturer-known as "Cepo Colombiano,"

which is putting a musket across the back of the neck and an other under the thighs, joined by cords, which are tightened till the head is forced between the knees.

A piece of wood was put into my mouth as a gag, and tied behind my neck, to prevent me crying out.

I faintly under this torture, reviving now and then enough to feel that they were throwing water in my face.

After three or four hours rest, I was taken up to the second day of my imprisonment, and all his clothes were covered with blood from the wound;

they then tore off his clothes and left him with only a shirt for a day and two nights; so great was the quantity of blood he lost that they had to use a pickaxe on the stone floor

to remove the stain. Doctors Stajano and Brendel have deposed to all the injuries inflicted on Volpi and Patroni,

who are themselves unable to sign this, owing to said injuries.

PROCLAMATION OF THE CHARGE. I had to fulfil a great and sacred duty, before my King and the Italians, under the actual circumstances:

I had to protest with energy against the horrible deeds perpetrated by agents of the Oriental Government against two of our countrymen.

Today I declare to you that I have fulfilled this impetuous duty, free of all animosity and with no other view than the safeguard of our legitimate rights,

of our standing as Italians and of the honor of our flag; but, before my King and the Italians, I find that instead of treating with the high responsibility that enforces the law in the country of your honest labor,

with the strong arm of justice, which, unsophisticated, lays aside interests, I have been met with makeshifts and sophisms

that are an open offence to the representative of a friendly nation and a negative in due form to my just requests and yours.

My line of policy is more clear. I will request instruction from the Royal Government, and, awaiting same, I will suspend all diplomatic relations with the Government

Volpi and Patroni, which, if confirmed, would affect the authorities concerned and even that of the country. The Executive considers it a duty to call the attention of Y.E. to such a serious matter and requests that the authorities under your jurisdiction adopt all the necessary measures as soon as possible.

NOTE TO THE FISCAL. Montevideo, March 23 1882. Mr Fiscal

The Executive has heard with profound displeasure of the denunciations made by the Italians Volpi and Patroni, who were at first arrested on suspicion of complicity in the Calle Juncal crime. These facts are of so serious a nature and affect to such a degree the character of the authorities that the Executive deems it necessary to begin a solemn investigation before the Tribunal.

Although the appearance of the plaintiff in these cases must be awaited, the Executive thinks that in the present circumstances it is necessary to call the special attention of the Fiscal, owing to the notoriety of the accusations and to the fact that the imputed crime reflects on the honour and credit of our civilized country. The Executive requests you to devote all your energy to the investigation of the truth without loss of time, that speedy justice be done, chastising the authors of the crime, if confirmed, and the false denouncers, if otherwise.

After the publication of the above notes the Italian organ of Montevideo published a fly-sheet, signed by the President and members of the several associations and thanking both the Consul and Commander for their energetic conduct in the document goes on to say that Italians love Orientals very much, but dislike the degenerate sons that rule the country.

Perfect harmony reigns between the Italians, their ex-Consul and Commander of the fleet.

SANTOS'S MANIFESTO. President Santos, on withdrawal of the Charge d'Affaires of Italy, published the following manifesto to the Italian population of Montevideo.

Your National authorities have deserted from their posts; they have abandoned their prerogatives and their obligations towards you.

Their motives for such a serious step are consigned in the notes of the 24th inst; as you will have seen, the Government has done its utmost to solve a conflict that it sincerely deplores.

The President of the Republic takes the post abandoned to assure you of the usufruct of all your rights and guarantees; if possible, however, these will be more respected than ever.

Remain assured, therefore, and trust to a word which has never been broken.

Writing on the subject of General Skobeleff's recent speeches, the St. Petersburg Herald announces that measures have been taken which will prevent any Russian public servant in a high position from taking the liberty of discussing matters of State policy on his own account.

The Herzegovinian insurgents being pursued by Austrian troops, are escaping into Montenegro. Several thousands of them are already encamped across the frontier, and are described as suffering great hardships. Several encounters have taken place in Bosnia between the Austrian troops and the insurgents.

The most serious seems to have occurred near Brod, in which the insurgents' loss is estimated at forty killed and sixty wounded.

Telegrams have reached Paris reporting quarrels between Araby Bey and Mahmoud Baroudi, and intimating the probability of the former almost immediately becoming Prime Minister.

The French Chamber of Deputies, on Saturday, adopted the Bill extending to English imports the most favored nation clauses. M. Tirard, the present Minister of Commerce, said he would be only too glad to conclude a Treaty with England, but the Government must choose its own time.

A disastrous explosion has occurred at a colliery at Leober, in Styria. Two of the superintendents were killed, and it is believed that one hundred and fifty miners have lost their lives.

Our New York Correspondent telegraphs the substance of some correspondence which has ensued out of an invitation sent to the Pope to remove the Vatican to Quebec.

Whist refusing the offer of a domicile in America, Leo XIII. says the time for removal from Rome has come.

Sir S. L. Tilley, in making his statement on the Canadian Budget, mentioned that the sale of land in the north-west would more than pay all the expenses incurred in making the Pacific railroad.

The Princess Mary distributed the prizes on Saturday to the successful competitors in the shooting matches of the Queen's Westminister Volunteers, and also presented two silver cups to the Duke of Westminster in testimony of his support of the Volunteer cause.

At the dinner which followed, Sir Garnet Wolseley expressed a hope that the time would come when every regiment in the Army would consist of battalions of Regulars, of Militia, and of Volunteers.

A large meeting of Sussex farmers, held at Mayfield, on Saturday, passed a resolution urging the speedy abolition of extraordinary tithes.

Two men have been arrested on suspicion of stealing the body of the late Earl of Crawford and Balcarres. One is a mechanic named Kirkwood, who was employed on the estate, and the other whose name is Philip, was until lately drill instructor to the Volunteers upon the estate.

Bernard Bailey, who some time ago gave information to the police which led to the seizure of a large quantity of Fenian arms and ammunition in Dublin, was shot dead on Saturday night, in an alley in Dublin. He had been living under the protection of the police until recently.

No one saw the murderer committed, but there are two bullet wounds through the head, the man having been dead half an hour before his body was discovered. The police have no clue to the murderer.

Mr. Bradlaugh, speaking at the Free Trade Hall, Manchester, last night, declared that he was again elected for Northampton in April, but the grave should prevent him from taking his seat.

The Stock Markets were inactive on Saturday, but prices were fairly supported. In English Railways Brighton Deferred, Metropolitan District, and Great Northern A closed about 1 per cent higher, and other descriptions rose 1/2 to 1/4. American Railways experienced a general recovery ranging from 1 to 2 dollars, and Canadian Lines were steady.

Foreign Bonds showed no material change, excepting in Russian and Spanish, which left off dull. Consols were 1/16 easier for the account, but the price for money was unaltered. Gold to the value of 243,000 was sent into the Bank of England.

The whole town has gone off its head about Volpi and Patroni, and if Dr Plaza, our Minister of Foreign Affairs, does not take immediate and energetic steps in the matter, his Government will very soon discover that this unprecedented outrage is more calculated to injure this Republic than even the Oriental.

We look for the most determined and explicit notes from our Minister of Foreign Affairs to both the Oriental and Italian Governments, and for a probable complication arising in Bulgaria.

Several of the Ambassadors at Constantinople have handed to the Porte replies to the recent Turkish Note on the question of ceremonial to be observed towards the European consuls. The pretensions of

this atrocious Volpi and Patroni case. The Italians, when they read the horrid details of the countrymen's torture, will emigrate to any other land under the sun, Kamenskata or Hong Kong, in preference to the Plate. Our Immigration returns for 1882 will take a jump back 20 years, if our Government is not careful to clear the Argentine Republic from imputations which its geography and close proximity to Montevideo secure for it. The horror which the Buenos Ayrean public has felt on reading the shocking tortures these unfortunate human beings were subjected to should be expressed in a note from our Minister of Foreign Affairs. We all know that the Argentine Cabinet is shocked at the barbarities perpetrated on these poor Italians, but the best interests of the nation demand that the feelings of the people and the Government be expressed in a formal and official note to the Italian Minister, and our Minister would not go much out of the way if we also plainly and honestly expressed the sympathy we feel for those poor Italians and the unanimous desire of all to have the satanic agents who perpetrated these atrocities punished.

Owing to the delivery of the Neva's mails, last yesterday afternoon and the great pressure of the Volpi and Patroni papers on our columns, we are obliged to hold over for tomorrow our report of the meetings and demonstrations yesterday on the occasion of Mr. Bridget leaving us. Three separate offerings of regard to Mr. Bridget took place yesterday, which is rather an unusual occurrence in our limited British circle. The affair at the Agulla was largely attended by our commercial community, and the speech of the chairman, Mr. Carroll, was worthy of his very high reputation as a polished public speaker. We hold for tomorrow the interesting details, as the papers and documents are too long to be squeezed into our narrow space at so advanced an hour.

Earlier in the day the Gun Club presented Mr. Bridget with a valuable diamond ring, in Mr. Hower's house, Mr. L. Correa Morales being spokesman. At the Gun Club the Rowing and Cricket Clubs presented him with a purse of £150. At the Agulla the merchants' present was a gold watch, to be purchased by Mr. Carlyle in London, an album, and a cheque for £350. Mr. Bridget left in the evening for Montevideo, and the British demonstration as he 'showed off' was something tremendous.

Volpi and Patroni have forced us to give our esteemed Rosario correspondent a back seat in the Supplement today. There is with it a short letter from Cordoba, by which it will be seen that the decision of the Supreme Court in the Limits Question has given every man in that province a good laugh, if not a cramp in his stomach. Alas, what do a few hundred leagues of land matter to a large province like Joroboa?

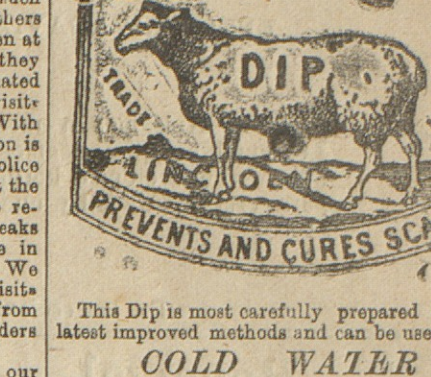

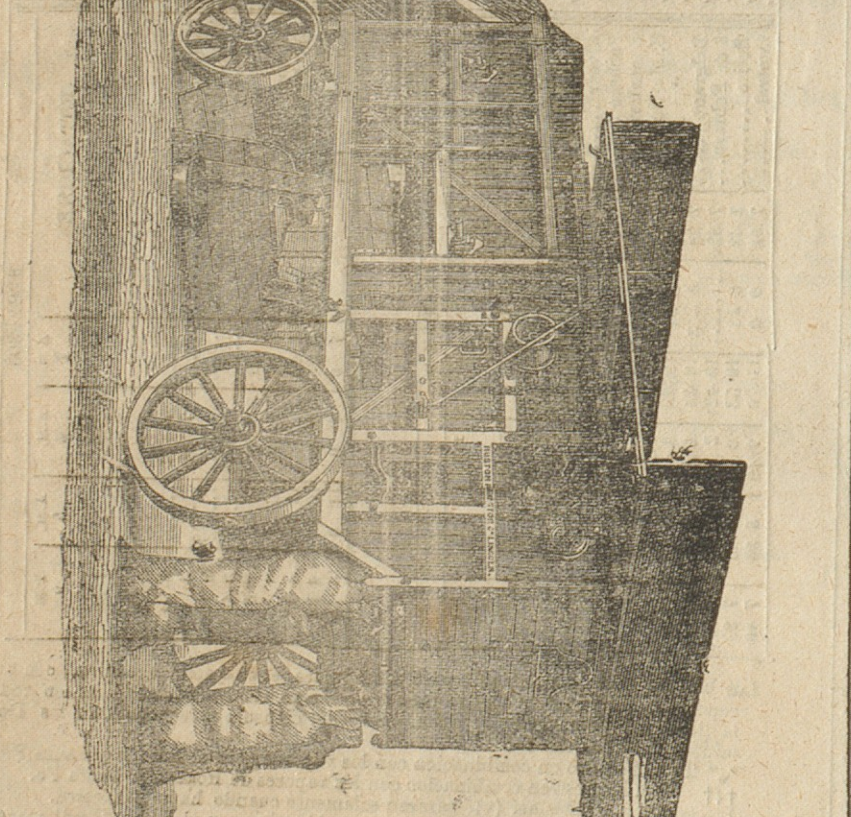
