FRENCH SYNDICATES. As we have so much now-a-days to do with French syndicates, the following articles received by the mail may prove interesting.

NAVAL MATTERS

There is no way of accounting for the heap of abuses that have been allowed on the navy of this country; the most serious attacks always proceeded from a native contemporary, who took special delight in exaggerating every short-coming, and was often led astray in the publication of facts, which, to say the least, were mistaken.

Those who have had an opportunity of reading the decks of the ships of the navy will acknowledge that they are kept in the most scrupulous order, and discipline is observed in the strictest sense of the word.

Proprietors are aware that their financial year now ends in June, and not December. Consequently the present period, ending on the 31st of the current financial year, is the first full year of the company's operations.

It is true that in the year there has been the additional benefit of the International Exhibition, which may have helped the profitable balance somewhat, but since the close of that exhibition the traffic has continued to increase most satisfactorily.

The population of the City of Buenos Aires used to be a year or two back 250,000, and it is estimated to be now something over 300,000.

The extraordinary case of Miss Fancher of Brooklyn, N. Y., who has been dead for three months, and is now reported to be alive, is a most extraordinary one.

CITY OF BUENOS AIRES TRAMWAYS

Before commencing the work of observation we have to take up the affairs of this Company, which we would remark upon the curious circumstance that some of the daily papers persist in calling the Company the "Buenos Aires Tramways," which is not the "Buenos Aires Trams."

That which is about to be paid is at the rate of 10 per cent. per annum (annuus interest), and in addition to it sums are added to the reserve fund and to the contingent fund.

When the new shares were issued about this time last year, raising the ordinary capital from \$450,000 to \$600,000, it was said the 10 per cent. dividend could not be kept up on the enlarged capital.

In the year the gross receipts from the sale of the shares of the Company were \$1,435,596.12, against \$1,134,596.12 in the previous year, an increase of \$300,000.
