Panama papers of January 4th reached us yesterday. The Canal is going ahead briskly, and navies for the world arrive almost daily from the W. Indies. One curious effect of all the bustle caused by the Canal is the push in diving for pearl oysters, and gems of enormous size and value have been found.

The iron plate that covered the foundation stone of the city in Plaza Victoria has been taken away and replaced by a solid block of granite. It was about time.

The English factory for making "al-pargas" in Avenida Santa Lucia, was formally opened on Tuesday. Messrs. Etchegaray and Fraser are the proprietors, and they are safe to make a colossal fortune. The building is a spacious one, and constructed specially for the work. There are over thirty different machines at work. Like bacon and ham making in the United States, the hog—we mean the fibre, is put at one end and comes out at the other, ready for our Gallego friends to put on. The whole operation takes only a few minutes, and 12,000 pair per day can be turned out; just now, however, 1,800 is the figure. The enterprising proprietors intend also to make their own "lona," the only foreign article that they now use. Just it might be thought that the new firm will entail blue ruin on all the poor people who now earn their bread by making "al-pargas," we may state that the daily consumption of same for the whole country, is estimated at 20,000 pairs. Perhaps the greatest claim the new firm has on public support is that all its work people are women, from two women of 8 to venerable ladies of 50. We wish the new firm every brightest success. It is the only factory in the kind in the world, but Mr. Etchegaray will open a twin factory in Bilbao in May next.
