

## THE LINSEED CROP.

For the last three years the yield of the linseed plantations of this Republic has been falling off in a most remarkable manner, so much so that there are serious apprehensions that this season's crop will prove a failure. The splendid results of the first crops, only a few years ago, inspired the greatest hopes that linseed would before long become one of the most important export staples of the country, and the comparatively small profits reaped from wheat and maize growing induced the majority of farmers to start linseed plantations.
